Treasury Warrant Number thirteen thousand six hundred and eighty two
Issued the third day of August one thousand seven hundred and eighty
two, there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto Benjamin Satter
Apigee of Jenny Floyd Apigee of Benjamin Satterland who was
Apigee of James Clark a certain Tract or parcel of Land contain-
ing four hundred acres by Survey bearing date the 10th day of July
1785 lying and being in the County of Jefferson on the Muddy fork
of Bear Grass adjoining the land of John Floyd deceased on the
North and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a hock Ash
Sugar tree and ^{Neck} corner to John Floyd thence with his line ^{N 53 E 390 poles to a Sugar tree in said line} N 37 W 180
poles to a Sugar tree in a line of Hancock Eustace Military Survey
with his & Hugh Mercers lines S 47 W 391 poles to a Sugar tree in
Southall & Charltons line, with the same S 37 E 148 poles to the
Beginning with its Appurtenances to have and to hold the said tract
or parcel of Land with its Appurtenances to the said ~~Benjamin~~ ^{Benjamin} Satterland &
his Heirs forever In Witness whereof the said Patrick Henry Esq^r Governor
of the Commonth of Virginia hath hereunto set his hand & caused the
seper Seal of the said Commonth to be affixed at Richmond on the 27th day
in the year of our Lord 1786. & of the Commth the Eleventh
