shall come, Greeting: KNOW YE, that by virtue and in consideration of a Land Office Recompense Warrant No.

669

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there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto *John Floyd* Executive of Col.

*John Floyd* Decd. now intermarried with *Alexander Breckinridge*

a certain tract or parcel of Land containing four hundred Acres by Survey bearing date the twenty ninth day of Novemb: 1790, lying and being in the County of Jefferson on the muddy fork of Beargrass adjoining Col: Christian and Col: Floyds Military Survey on the North and Bounded as followeth To wit Beginning at three Beches near the muddy fork of Beargrass, in Christian's line and 160 Poles from his Floyds corner running from thence North thirty seven degrees West 234 Poles to a Stake in the line of Mr: Peaches 1000 Acres Military Survey & in Jacob Snodgers field, thence with Peaches line South 45° West 180 Poles to a Buckeye and Hickory on a ledge come to Peaches and ~~Howard's~~ *Howard's* Survey line: ~~South 47°~~ *South 47°* ~~West 170 Poles~~ *West 170 Poles* to two Sugar trees, and Beech in said line, thence South 37° E. 170 Poles to two Sugar trees, and Beech in a line of Floyds old Military Survey, thence with the same Christians line North 53° East 329 Poles to the Beginning

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with its appurtenances. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances to the said *John Floyd*

John Floyd Decd. now intermarried, and his heirs forever. IN WITNESS whereof, the said *Isaac Shelby*

Alexander Breckinridge Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, hath hereunto set his hand and caused the seal
