KENTUCKY HIGH SCHOOLS — 1968-69

Kentucky public and private high schools are classified and accredited by the State Board of Education. This requirement is set forth in the law which requires that each school district in the state provide an approved twelve-grade school service and that rules and regulations be adopted governing the quality of this service. The law also provides that the "Superintendent of Public Instruction shall annually prepare or cause to be prepared and submit for approval and publication by the State Board of Education a list of all public and private high schools or other secondary schools in the state, showing their classifications." Accredited classifications are given each year by official action of the Kentucky State Board of Education on recommendations of the staff in the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, State Department of Education. The Committee on Secondary schools has worked in close cooperation with the staff of the Division of Elementary and Secondary Education in an advisory capacity on arriving at the recommended ratings.

The number of high schools classified and accredited annually continued to decline during the last ten years. This year there are 429 high schools, nine (9) less than in 1967-68. Table I which follows shows the number of schools classified according to the type of organization and the controlling authority under which they operate.

Of the 429 schools operating, 364 are high schools offering a Program of Studies through the twelfth grade, and are considered complete high schools. The complete high schools show a decline from year to year which means that the high schools are becoming larger making it practicable to offer a broader Program of Studies for the youth of the State.

Table II shows the number of complete high schools and the change in number for a sixteen-year period from 1953-54 to 1968-69. In this period of time, the number of high schools have decreased from 539 to 364 or 175 fewer than existed 16 years ago.

It is the purpose of Table III to show the breakdown according to the size of the complete high schools and the control under which they are operated. In the county school district it will be seen that only 2 schools with an enrollment of 99 pupils or below remain. This year, there is a total number of 153 high schools with an enrollment of 500 and above. Last year, this number was 142 which is 11 high schools more than last year, with enrollments of more than 500 pupils.

Of the 364 complete high schools, it will be noticed that 224 are operated by the county school districts; 75 are under control of independent districts; 9 are state or federal and 56 are private schools.

The common type of high school organization conforms to either a six-year high school, grades 7-12; for a four-year high school, grades 9-12. For a number of years, the trend has been moving away from the six-year high school organization to the four-year high school organization. It will be observed, that this year there are 93 six-year high schools and 242 four-year high school organizations. Last year there were 106 six-year high schools and 248 four-year high schools. By far the greatest number of these schools are organized as grades 9-12.

In Table IV, there is an accumulation of information concerning the number of high schools representing the growth since 1958-59 to 1968-69. It is interesting to notice that since the school year of 1958-59 when there were 533 schools that there are now only 429 or a decrease of 104 schools in this period of time. This is evidence that the high schools of the Commonwealth of Kentucky are becoming larger and therefore offering the potentials of providing a stronger program of education.

The number of pupils enrolled in the high schools continues to increase. This year there has been an increase of over 6,386 pupils enrolled in grades 7-12 from 260,942 in 1967-68 to 267,328 in 1968-69.

Table VI which follows gives the enrollment in all types of high schools in the state, grades 7-12 classified according to the type of control under which the school operates.

The greatest increase in the number of pupils enrolled in the high schools this year occurred in the county school districts. This increase in the county school districts numbered 12,681 pupils from 168,949 in 1967-68 to 181,630 in 1968-69.

Table VII is presented to show the growth in the high schools of the State for 11 years, from 1958-59 to 1968-69.
