The University of Kentucky Library Staff Organization will hold a business meeting on Wednesday, July 3, to vote on the revised constitution (distributed to the staff earlier this month). Meeting place is the MIK/North staff room.

LIBRARY RANKING

With the addition of 72,000 volumes last year to the University Libraries' collection, holdings in the King Library and in the eleven branch libraries now total 1.3 million volumes. This ranks UK 54th among the 81 members of the Association of Research Libraries.

The library ranks 13th in the nation in total microforms held, which number 1,059,178. In the number of periodicals held and subscribed to, the library ranks 14th, with 33,000.

The Association of Southeastern Research Libraries, with 23 members, ranks UK seventh in number of volumes held.
