President McVey announced the ruling of the Board of Trustees in reference to the request of the Senate that members of the teaching staff be permitted to take work in the University without payment of fees. Following is an excerpt from the minutes of the Board of Trustees:

"After hearing the report, the Committee said that in the case of Barker vs Crum, the question of free tuition was determined and that no action on the resolution of the Senate is necessary, members of the University staff not being entitled to free tuition."
