A drive by studenta, faculty members, and alumni is being inaugurated at the University of Wisconsin roobtain money for the student loan fund of that institution. Fifteen that distinct benefit is a student body, and at present a drive for an additional 10,000 to be donated by university officials and alumni is under way. These students have no collateral and cannot borrow from banks or other lending institutions at a reasonable rate of interest. The scarcity of employment makes it impossible for most of them to finance, their education by their own labors.
