

Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the University of Kentucky, Tuesday, December 11, 1990.

The Board of Trustees of the University of Kentucky met at 4:00 p.m. (Lexington time) on Tuesday, December 11, 1990 in the Board Room on the 18th floor of Patterson Office Tower on the Lexington campus.

A. Meeting Opened and Roll Called

Mr. Foster Ockerman, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m., and the invocation was pronounced by Mr. Ted Bates.

The following members of the Board of Trustees answered the call of the roll:

The University administration was represented by President Charles T. Wethington, Jr.; Chancellors Peter P. Bosomworth and Robert E. Hemenway, Jr.; Acting Chancellor Ben W. Carr, Jr.; Vice Presidents Edward A. Carter and Eugene Williams, Acting Vice President Leonard K. Peters; Mr. C. M. Newton; and Mr. John C. Darsie, General Counsel.

Members of the news media were also in attendance. A quorum being present, the Chairman declared the meeting officially open for the conduct of business at 4:05 p.m.

B. Minutes Approved

Mr. Ockerman stated that the Minutes of the October 23, 1990 Board of Trustees meeting had been distributed and asked for corrections or additions. The Minutes were approved as distributed.

C. President's Report to the Trustees (PR 1)

President Wethington reviewed the following items in PR 1:

1. The number of new UK Fellows for one year nearly doubled the past year, rising from 254 to 465.
2. Kentucky's rural health initiative was officially launched at a November 8 news conference in Hazard. Governor Wallace Wilkinson and other state officials were in attendance.
3. Twelve of the world's leading equine research scientists have been inducted into the Equine Research Hall of Fame at the University of Kentucky.

4. Private gifts to the community colleges through September, 1990 topped \$1,000,000.00.
5. Kentucky River Coal Corporation announced that it will give \$250,000 to the endowment phase of the campaign for Hazard Community College. The gift is designated for the scholarship program.

After elaborating on each of the items, President Wethington asked that the Board review the other significant items in the report at their leisure.

D. Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Self-study

President Wethington noted that every ten years the University of Kentucky and other institutions take a comprehensive look at themselves to chart some direction for the future. The University recently started this broad, comprehensive process which involves the administration, faculty, students, and the Board of Trustees. The first action to be presented to the Board will be the mission statement for the University with recommended modifications by the Self-study Steering Committee. President Wethington introduced Dr. James Hoagland, chairperson of the Self-study Steering Committee, and Dr. David Nash, vice chairperson of the Self-study Steering Committee, and asked them to brief the Board on the Self-study Steering Committee.

Dr. Hoagland reviewed the important aspects of the self-study accreditation exercise and stated that the accreditation exercise through the institutional self-study provides an opportunity for people at the University to take a good, critical look at the institution. The primary purpose of the University System Self-study is to improve the effectiveness of the institution in fulfilling its mission and to provide professional judgments of the quality of the programs. He stated the following objectives of the self-study:

1. Evaluate the effectiveness of the University in fulfilling its mission as the Commonwealth's principal institution for instruction, research and public service.
2. Promote awareness within the University of its potential for leadership in the state, nation, and the world.
3. Identify the University's strengths and weaknesses and improve the quality of personnel, programs and services.
4. Support the University's efforts in its strategic planning.
5. Obtain reaffirmation of accreditation with the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

He said that everyone involved in the self-study is mindful of the importance of reaffirmation of accreditation and the process provides an important opportunity for the University and its continuing development.

Dr. Nash reported on the responsibilities and make up of the Self-study Steering Committee and stated that it provides the focus for the activities of the faculty, staff and students in accomplishing the important, significant task. He reviewed the schedule for the self-study and stated that the committee's goal is not only to gain reaffirmation but also to build on the strengths and weaknesses of the University so that it can become a better institution in the future. He noted that previous self studies have had a major influence on important developments at the University and said that he is confident that this self-study will also have a constructive impact on the future of the University.

President Wethington emphasized the importance of this sizable undertaking and commented on the enormous amount of effort and time involved in the task. He said that the self-study needs to be taken seriously and everyone at the University is committed to doing the task well and thoroughly, and in a fashion that will lead to improvement of the University. He assured the Board that the administration will take these matters seriously as they plan for the University's future.

E. Personnel Actions (PR 2)

On motion made by Mr. Burnett, seconded by Mr. Stricker and passed, approval was given to the routine personnel actions set forth in PR 2. (See PR 2 at the end of the Minutes.)

President Wethington noted for the record the retirement of Dr. Otis A. Singletary, President Emeritus, Professor of History and holder of the Otis A. Singletary Professorship in the Humanities, effective December 31, 1990. He stated that Dr. Singletary will continue to hold the title of President Emeritus and will continue to have an office on campus.

F. Proposed Amendments to the Governing Regulations (PR 3A)

President Wethington reported that PR 3A had been withdrawn.

G. Report on Results of Alumni Members' Elections (PR 3B)

President Wethington stated that Mr. Ted B. Bates' and Judge Julia K. Tackett's terms expire December 31, 1990, and PR 3B reports the results of the recent alumni elections. He reported the three persons from each ballot receiving the highest number of votes were:

Ballot No. 2

Julia Kurtz Tackett  
Joe B. Hall  
Kay Shropshire Bell

He noted that both Mr. Bates and Judge Tackett are eligible for reelection. He then recommended that the report be received and put to record, and the Assistant Secretary, in the absence of the Secretary, be authorized to certify to the Governor the names of the persons receiving

the largest number of votes, from which list successors will be appointed. It was the consensus of the Board to approved PR 3B. (See PR 3B at the end of the Minutes.)

H. Candidates for Degrees - Community College System (PR 4A)

Mr. Bates moved that the degrees specified in PR 4A be awarded to the persons named, upon certification that the requirements for those degrees have been satisfactorily completed. The motion, seconded by Dr. Meriwether, carried. (See PR 4A at the end of the Minutes.)

I. Appointment of President, Paducah Community College (PR 4B)

President Wethington called upon Acting Chancellor Ben Carr to comment on PR 4B.

Dr. Carr indicated his pleasure in recommending the appointment of Dr. Leonard F. O'Hara for the presidency of Paducah Community College, effective February 1, 1991. He briefly reviewed Dr. O'Hara's credentials and stated that Dr. O'Hara will make an excellent president for the college.

On motion made by Mr. Wilcoxson, seconded by Mr. Stricker and passed, Dr. O'Hara was named President of Paducah Community College. (See PR 4B at the end of the Minutes.)

Professor Bratt stated that there are no women as presidents of the community colleges and inquired as to whether or not there will be an attempt to address the issue. She noted that more than 55% of the faculty of the community colleges are female, a pool much larger than that for research institutions.

Dr. Carr assured Professor Bratt that the issue would be addressed in the two searches currently underway.

J. Candidates for Degrees - University System (PR 5A)

Professor Bratt moved that the President be authorized to confer upon each individual whose name appears on the attached lists the degree to which he or she is entitled upon certification by the University Registrar that the individual has satisfactorily completed all requirements for the degree for which application has been made and as approved by the University Senate. Her motion was seconded by Mr. Bates and unanimously carried. (See PR 5A at the end of the Minutes.)

K. Acceptance of Interim Financial Report for the University of Kentucky for the Four Months Ended October 31, 1990 (FCR 1)

Mr. Ockerman reported that the Finance Committee had met and recommends that the Board accept the interim financial report. Mr. Burnett so moved. The motion was seconded by Mr. Rose and passed. (See FCR 1 at the end of the Minutes.)

L. Disposal of Personal Property (FCR 2)

Mr. Ockerman recommended that the Board approve the routine report on the Disposition of Personal Property. Mr. Stricker so moved. The motion, seconded by Judge Tackett, passed. (See FCR 2 at the end of the Minutes.)

M. Report on Leases (FCR 3)

Mr. Ockerman reminded the Board that the President has the authority to approve leases which are under \$30,000 and recommended that the Board accept FCR 3. Professor Rhoads so moved. Her motion was seconded by Mr. Burnett and carried. (See FCR 3 at the end of the Minutes.)

N. 1990-91 Budget Revisions (FCR 4)

Mr. Ockerman stated that FCR 4 pertains to budget revisions and entertained a motion for approval. Mr. Wilcoxson moved that the 1990-91 budget revisions be approved. Mr. Farmer seconded the motion, and it carried. (See FCR 4 at the end of the Minutes.)

O. Professorships in Various Colleges

Mr. Ockerman reported that FCR 5 through FCR 12 relate to professorships in various colleges. He stated that he would review all of the professorships and take one motion if that was agreeable to the Board. The members concurred and Mr. Ockerman reviewed the following professorships:

On motion made by Professor Bratt, seconded by Judge Stephens and carried, FCR's 5 through 12 were approved. (See FCR's 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 at the end of the Minutes.)

P. Patent Assignments

Mr. Ockerman reported that FCR 13 through 16 are patent assignments and, likewise, he will take one vote after reviewing the assignments. The members concurred, and Mr. Ockerman reviewed the patent assignments. On motion made by Mr. Ulmer and seconded by Mr. Lohman, the patent assignments were approved. (See FCR's 13, 14, 15, and 16 at the end of the Minutes.)

Q. Student Volunteer Activities

Mr. Ockerman expressed thanks and appreciation to Mr. Lohman and the students involved in the recent volunteer projects that had been generated throughout the campus.

U. University System Senate Reception

President Wethington reminded the members of the University System holiday reception immediately following the meeting at the Helen King Alumni House and encouraged the Board to attend.

Professor Bratt stated that representatives from the various colleges and departments would be in attendance and endorsed President Wethington's encouragement to the Board to attend the reception.

R. Dinner at Maxwell Place

President Wethington reminded the Board of their invitation to dinner at Maxwell Place and expressed pleasure in entertaining the members at Maxwell Place.

S. Meeting Adjourned

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Chairman adjourned the meeting at 4:45 p.m.

Recommendation: the the following proposed amendments to the Governing Regulations of the University of Kentucky be received at this time for preliminary consideration and, at the next meeting of the Board of Trustees, be included on the agenda for action.

(Note: Proposed additions are underlined; proposed deletions are bracketed.)

Amendment #1 -- Change Part III, last paragraph, to read:

In the event of a vacancy in the office of President or disability of the President, the Vice President for Administration shall exercise the functions of the President in the absence of the appointment of an Interim President by the Board of Trustees. If the Board finds it desirable to appoint an Interim President, it shall seek advice from a joint Board-Faculty-Student committee if such has been constituted to recommend the appointment of a President or, if the committee has not been constituted, from the University Senate Council.

Background: This amendment has been proposed by Mr. Sean Lohman, President of the University of Kentucky Student Government Association, as a way to ensure effective student representation in the process of selecting an interim president.

Amendment #2 -- Change Part VIII.A.1, first paragraph, to read:

The President of the University is appointed by the Board of Trustees with the advice of a joint committee of the Board, faculty, and student body. The committee shall consist of five members of the Board appointed by its chairman; three members of the full-time teaching and/or research faculty of the University System, selected by a procedure determined by the University Senate; one member of the full-time teaching faculty of the Community College System, selected by a procedure determined by the Community College Council; and one full-time student [appointed by the chairman of the Board], selected by a procedure determined by the University of Kentucky Student Government Association. The committee shall provide opportunity for discussion between representative administrative, faculty, and student groups and prospective presidential candidates.

Background: This amendment has been proposed by Mr. Sean Lohman, President of the University of Kentucky Student Government Association, as a way to ensure effective student representation in the process of selecting a president.



Background: A Search Committee was appointed by the Acting Chancellor of the Community College System in July 1990 to seek qualified candidates for the position of President, Paducah Community College. The Committee, composed of faculty representatives, a student representative, Paducah Junior College Board representatives and a representative from the community at large screened applications and made its recommendation to the Acting Chancellor. The candidates were then interviewed by the Acting Chancellor and Dr. O'Hara was chosen to be recommended to the President and Board of Trustees.

Dr. O'Hara has a bachelor's degree from Wake Forest University, a master's degree from the University of North Carolina, and a doctorate degree from the University of California at Los Angeles. He has successful administrative experience at Daytona Beach Community College in Daytona Beach, Florida, Wytheville Community College in Wytheville, Virginia and Northampton County Area Community College in Bethelhem, Pennsylvania.

Dr. O'Hara is an experienced community college administrator. He has demonstrated his leadership ability in the positions he has previously held and this makes him an excellent candidate for the presidency of Paducah Community College.


