Freshmen climb in Add/Drop ranks as semester begins

Being number two isn't often a position that is relished, but this year freshmen will welcome the opportunity.

Add/Drop, which traditionally kicks off the start of each semester, starts tomorrow and runs through Aug. 28.

While Add/Drop is nothing new to older students, freshmen will stand second in line to add or drop courses for the Fall 1990 session—a break from the past.

"Since (freshmen) are at the end of the file at Advance Registration, we're trying to let them have a chance to pick up what they need during Add/Drop," said Lisa Collins, director of registration.

Graduate students and seniors will Add/Drop first, followed by freshmen, juniors, sophomores, and non-degree students.

"Everybody who's involved in registration at UK fell like it was time that the freshmen were given an opportunity to get at the head of the line, so to speak," Collins said.

"If this goes well, we will continue with this scheme of graduate students and seniors first and then freshmen in the next Add/Drop."

In the past, there have been complications with computer system crashes, but Collins does not foreseen any problems this time. During Advance Registration and Summer Advising Conferences, there was no down time.

"We're going to try as hard as we can to keep the lines going, to keep the people going into the sites, getting what they need, and getting out of the sites, "Collins said.

Four candidates remain in search for next UK president

Only four finalists remain as the search committee charged with recommending UK's next president meets again tomorrow afternoon, seeking a replacement for former head David Roselle.

Gathering for a seventh time, the 10-member committee will meet after the regular Board of Trustees meeting on campus. The finalists will visit UK during the first two weeks of September, when BOT members hope to name as uccessor.

The finalists' visits include meeting with messes, students, faculty.

The finalists' visits include meeting with trustees, students, faculty, the administration and representatives from Lexington Community College. Each visit is expected to last a little more than a day.

ter Ockerman said the committee plans to present the finalists to the board at the Sept. 18 meeting.
Ockerman, who also chairs the BOT, said the committee will not rank the finalists, since the committee's purpose is to conduct the search, not nominate they president. None of the finalists' names will be released until the campus visits, but the four are "very well qualified individuals," Ockerman said. Confidentiality is provided to keep the finalists in the race.

The finalists are all "presidents of universities," he said, but that doesn't include community college officials.

Many say Interim president. Charles Wethington, who was community college chancellor before being named to the interim post, is the front-runner for the job, although Wethington has declined to discuss the presidential search.

Trustees could repeal \$125 international student fee By VICTORIA MARTIN

The UK Board of Trustees is expected to repeal a controversial fee aimed at international students when it meets tomorrow in its regular session.

The International Student Environment Committee, which is made up of students and faculty, examined the structure of the international student fee and recommend that the BOT rescind it, according to Student Government Association President Sean Lohman.
