I am glad to learn that you are about to have the happiness of revisiting Italy.

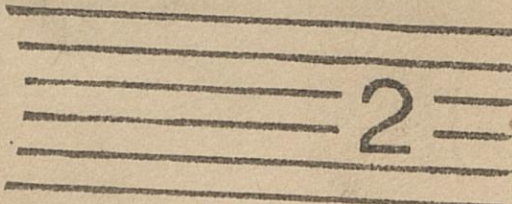
I regret that I have not a copy of my translation of the Vita Nuova which I could give myself the pleasure of offering to you. I presume that the book is in print, but I have made no enquiry

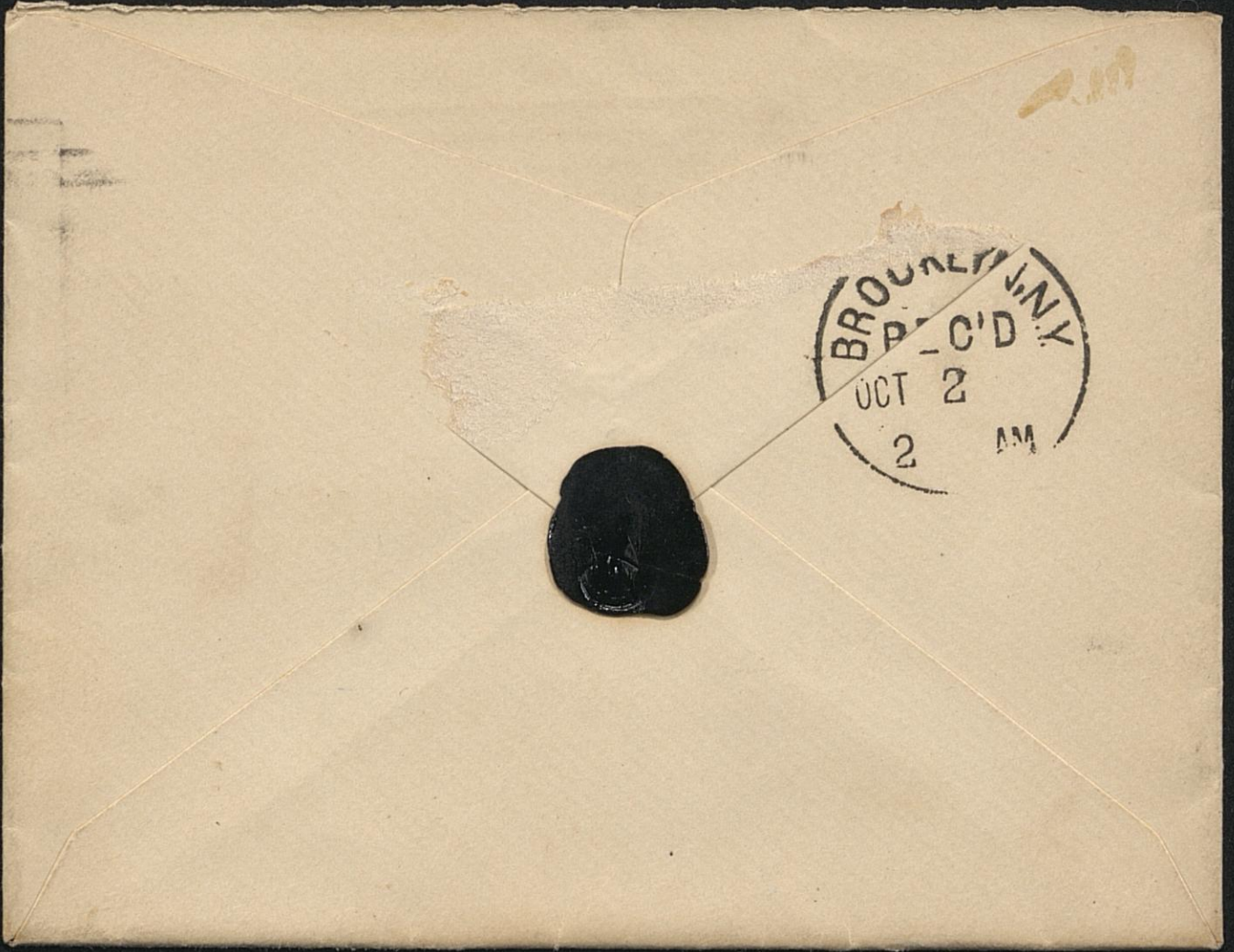
