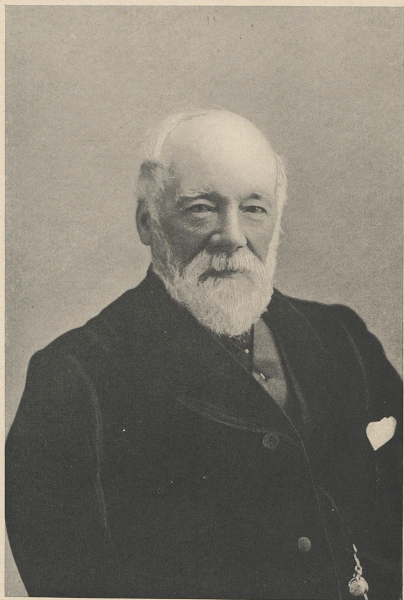

There is a book published by Reeves & Turner, of the Strand, of the Rev^d Mr. Cresswell, which gives a great deal of information. I think it is entitled History of the Huguenot Refuges & their Descendants. The best History of Protestantism in

France, is by M. Pucoux. It
is in six or seven volumes.
But it will scarcely be necessary
for you to consult it by a
book if you only propose to give
a single lecture. In my
"Huguenots in France, after the
Revocation", published by Routledge,
I have given a list of the
books I consulted, relative to the
Underground state of Protestantism
in France, from the Revocation of
the Edict of Nantes to the outbreak
of the French Revolution.
