I understood my friend Mr. Stevenson  
that he had forgotten to ask you a question  
when you were in Sheffield which obliquely  
concerned me - I have it in contemplation  
to publish a neat pocket Volume of somewhat  
more than 200 pages, connected with Derby-  
shire - the size the same as the little pam-  
phlet you have seen of mine "Modern Shat-  
terworth" - and I wish to know what will be  
your charge per sheet of 16 pages for 500 copies  
and also for 750 - The matter will be partly ori-  
ginal and partly selected and compressed from  
my Peak Survey - and as a companion for Der-  
byshire Travellers it will contain an ample  
account of all the places within the Peak  
district, usually visited by Tourists - I am

Strongly urged to this publication by my father,  
at Matlock and Buxton who feel confident of its  
success. I shall introduce five or six lithogra-  
phic views into the Volume which I think may  
be got out for 7s or so - give me your opinion  
and advise the views of which I have drawn  
into already made, include Chatsworth, Haddon  
Matlock Peak, Hole and Dove Dale. The title  
will be as follows or nearly so.

"The Peak Tourist, or the Derbyshire <sup>Traveller's</sup>  
Pocket Companion including an account  
of the various Places generally visited by  
Strangers, and the detail of an excursion  
from Dove Dale to Haddon Hall and Atten-  
Towers" To make my plan better under-  
stood I have added the Table of Contents  
as a Postscript - say if you think London will  
be best to publish it or not. I am dear Sir
