the Great Seal bearing date the 23^d. day of Janry last to create me Francis Earl of Godolphin
and Baron Godolphin of Rialton to be a Baron also of this Realm by the Name Title and
Stile of ~~Baron~~ Lord Godolphin Baron of Holston To have & hold the same to me the
said Earl & the Heirs males of my body, and for want of such unto Francis son of
D^r. Henry Godolphin ^{my Uncle} late Provost of Eaton deceased, & to the Heirs males of his Body: And
it being the indisputable Right of all Peers of this Realm to have Supporters to
their Arms ~~to be~~ ^{whenever} And Garter King of Arms having informed me that the
Supporters heretofore granted to my ^{late} father Sidney then Lord Godolphin Baron Godolphin of
Rialton ~~to attend upon that Barony as the same was granted by the Crown with~~ ^{to be born by him & the heirs males of his Body Barons of Right} ~~become~~
extinct in case I should dy without issue male of my body, whereby this Barony of
Holston will descend by virtue of the abovesaid Patent to the said Francis
Godolphin and the Heirs males of his body; I therefore make it my Request to your
Lordship ^{to grant & warrant by Garter King of Arms} that ~~in such case~~ the Supporters so formerly granted to attend upon the
Barony of Rialton ^{and now voided in me} ~~may be granted and assigned to such Person and Persons as the~~
said Barony of Holston shall descend according to the limitations in the said Patent
and that ^{whom} may be born by such Person and Persons to whom the said Barony of Holston
shall descend by virtue of the limitations in the said Patent.
