

CORBOULD, Edward Henry, English painter, b. in London, Dec. 5, 1815. Executed 'The Fall of Phaeton from the Chariot of the Sun,' 1834; 'Scene from the Prophète,' painted for the Queen; 'The Destruction of the Idols of Basle;' and various others. Appointed instructor of historical painting to the royal family, 1851.
