

Ernest Augustus, King of Hanover and Duke of Cumberland (*b.* 1771, *d.* 1851), fifth son of George III.; entered the English army, and rose to the rank of field-marshal; in 1815 married the Princess Frederica of Mecklenburg-Strelitz; succeeded to the crown of Hanover in 1837. 194, 16R, 2

Dear Sir

I just write you two lines by
this post though I wrote you a long letter by the
last mail, to say I have written this very day
to my brother recommending him to go through
