Darling:

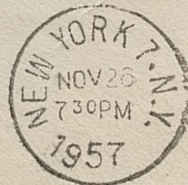
Your postal card with the bad news about your flight arrived this morning. I hope that you were not delayed too long. How-son must have had a long drive for nothing.
