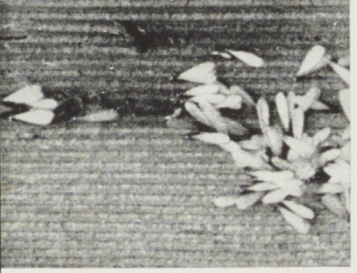
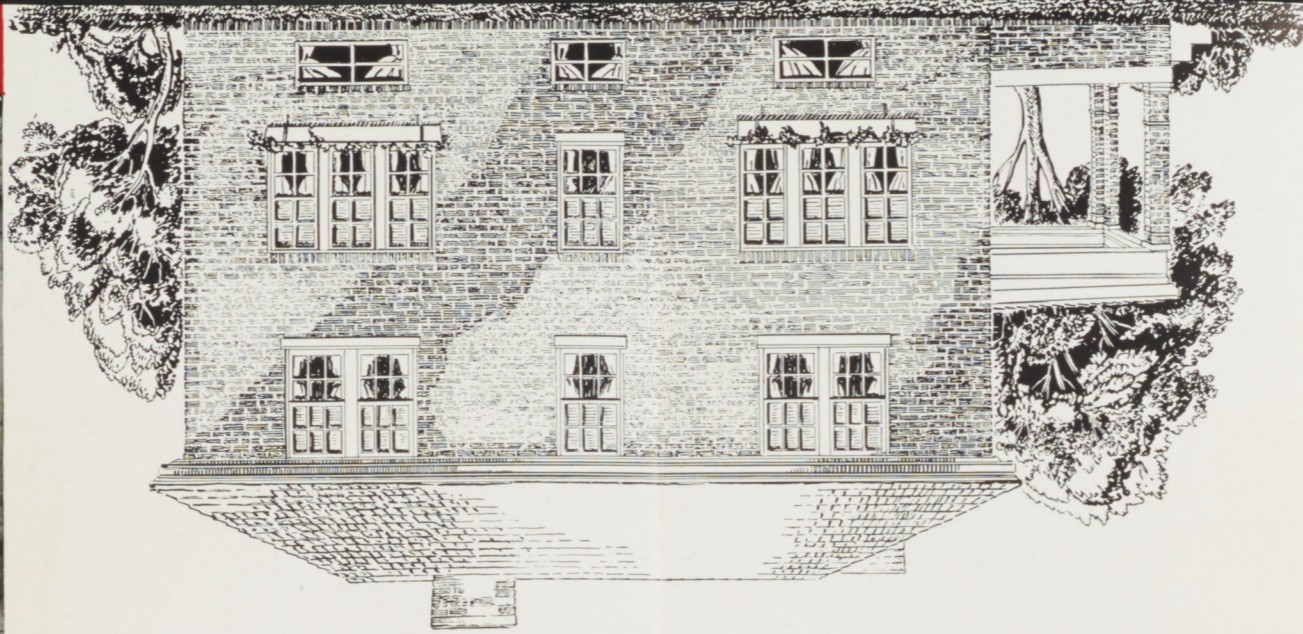


**YOU MIGHT SEE THESE SIGNS**

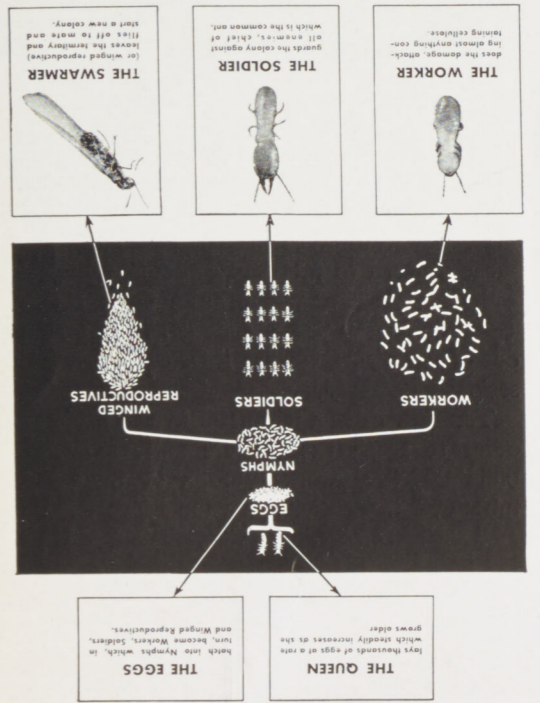


**INSIDE THE SHELTER TUBES** on the foundation wall (left) thousands of termites travel back and forth from their ground nests to the wood in the building above.

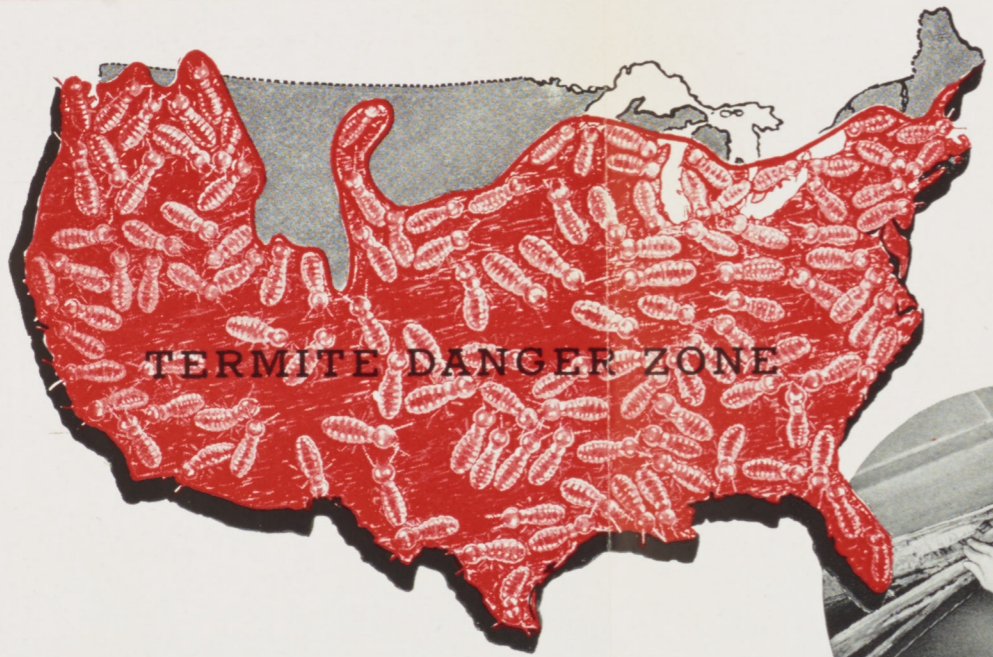

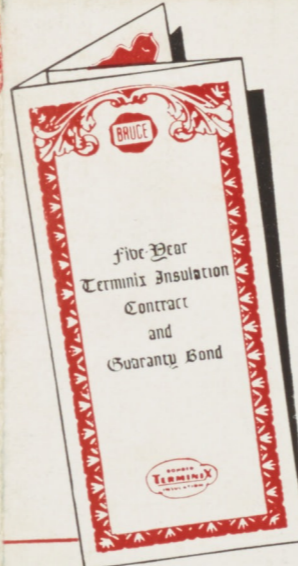
