John Bobb, Henry G. Weaver, Davis Weaver, John Beeler,
Christopher Beeler, John A. Atherton and Maria his wife,
late Maria Beeler, Henry S. Bunsley and Elyza his wife,
late Elyza Beeler, Minerva Beeler, Henry Beeler, Mary
Jane Beeler, Elizabeth Beeler, and William Beeler,
Jacob N. Trunnell and Melville his wife, late Melville
Scott, Robert L. Pottinger, and Ellen his wife, late
Ellen Scott, Henry Scott and John Scott, Samuel
Barnock, Samuel Barnock Jr. Mary Ann Barnock,
and Davis Barnock, did jointly and severally lease,
except the aforesaid Parties and names, who jointly
leased and demised, to the said John Doe, on
the 1st day of January 1834, in the state of Kentucky
and County of Nelson, a certain tenement and farm,
containing 500 acres of land, lying in Nelson County
on the North fork of Salt River, at the mouth of Lick
Creek, patented to Christopher Singleton, on the 18th
day of May 1790 - with the appurtenances. To have and
to hold the tenement aforesaid with the appurtenances,
unto the said John Doe and his assigns from the
1st day of January 1834, until the full term of twenty-
five years, thence next following, and fully to be com-
-pleted and ended, by virtue of which demise the said
John Doe, into the tenement aforesaid, with the appurtenances,
entered and was thereof possessed, until the said
