Sam^l. Martin to Henry Green deceased in 1783 for

Martin out of the above thousand acres in a conveni-
ent time after the said Willoughby shall pay for
the same it is also agreed between the parties that
the s^r. Willoughby do give at the rate of thirty five
pounds p^r hundred for all the land that shall be
left to the s^r. legal representatives of s^r. Henry Green ^{9th}
after a survey of Capt^t. William Kennedy and four hun-

Willoughby do on or before the first day of May
next pay to the s^r. Green three good second rate cows
and calves and three more good second rate cows and
