The deposition of Daniel Henderson taken at Not Johnsons
 House in South County the 4th day of Nov^r 1808
 to be read in evidence in a suit in Chancery in the
 Barbours Court Court wherein Abraham Boman
 is Complainant and Elijah Metton Defendant, This
 Dependant saith. That he lived at Bryants Station
 the latter end of the year 1780 and raised corn there in
 1781 & 1782. That he was acquainted with Raddles Station
 the greater part of that time. That Bryants Station
 was the nearest settlement to Raddles Station in 1781
 & 1782. That Bryants Station and Raddles Station were
 places of notary in 1781 & 1782. This deponent went
 in the year 1783 in the fall to ^{assist in} surveying a piece of land
 for Charles Gatliff on a run called Hunters Mill
 Creek at that time but since it is called Swanin
 The said Gatliffs claim was surveyed by Not Johnson
 joining Galaspies presumption the lower side.
 That this deponent & Not Johnson was at an Improve-
 -ment called Galaspies Improvement either as we
 went or returned from surveying said Gatliffs
 claim. Quert by Not Johnson for Compt. Was Raddles
 Station often called Lickin Station in the years 1781 & 1782
 by the people living at Bryants Station? Answer Yes.
 Quert by same - If a stranger had inquired of you
 in the years 1781 & 1782 to find a branch of Lickin
 Running in on the south side near Raddles Station
 would you have directed him to the branch now
 called Swanin? Answer Yes. I should have done it.
 but at that time it was called Hunters Mill Creek
 Quert by Not. Risher for Defendant. Did you know
 Improvement to be Daniel Galaspies of your own
 knowledge? Answer No. Quert by same. Who informed
 you it was Galaspies Improvement? Answer
 Not Johnson & Charles Gatliff at the time we went
