The finance plan which is at present under consideration by members of the university administration is another step which will place this institution in the forefront of modern education. Under the system which is being planned fraternities and other organized bodies on the campus will benefit in several ways.

Food will be purchased by a central agency, which is directly controlled by the university, for all the sorverities and fraternities. Figures

stained at other universities with millar systems show that a saving approximately 20 per cent can effected. With five per cent de-noted for the cost of administra-on of the project the organiza-nos included in the plan still are ectiving food at a 15 per cent re-

duction.

This, in itself, makes the arrangement one which will prove most beenficial to the Greek-Letter solucities of the campus. Pood bills naturally are the largest which the modern fraternity is called upon to meet and a 15 per cent decrease cannot but operate to their advantage. Prompt deliveries and good management naturally will be an integral part of the plan.




