I'm lying in there in a little while and try to find you something. I sure do hope I can find something nice for you. I know you get a big kick out of the things I send you. I wish I knew if you have received them for I've bought you something at each place except one place that didn't have anything worth ~~nothing~~. All I can say is that I love you more than anything in the world. You are my whole damn life and the only thing I care about in this world. I hope you can read this for I have to use my knee, no modern things at all in this dam base, if you can call this a base. See how the damn rain has dropped on this paper. Damn it anyway. I can't wait until we get the hell out of here.

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

Damn this war for taking you away from me. I would give anything to be back with you right now. I would be at the happiest damn guy in the world if we would head back to the states right now. Honey, I love you so damn much and want you. How much you like some passionate love making tonight. I get all hot and bothered just thinking about it. I want you so damn much and so does Oscar. He wants you and you love making so damn much. My whole body cries out for the want of your caress and love making. Do you feel the same way that I do about this? Are you as hungry as I am for that wonderful love making and all that wonderful fun. I can't wait until this damn war is over we can live a normal married life like it was intended for married people. Pray send word that this will all end as soon as it is possible. I really do think it will all be over in a very short time. At least all of the big shots seem to think so and we all will be home soon.

Tell your family all hello for me and I'll write to
 them as soon as I get to my final base. We
 have much more to go now and soon we shall
 be there. I will mail your knife to you as soon as
 we get there. I hope that it gets to you okay and
 all of the other things I sent to you. I do hope I
 have a bag full of mail waiting for me there.
 We have a fire built in the film because it is so
 damp around here. Well, it is getting late now
 and I shall hit the hay. Tell mom, I will write
 to her tomorrow night when I have to guard the
 ship again. It is about my turn again to do so.
 I will write you also tomorrow too. Darling, I
 wish you a Merry Christmas and no faults. Do
 have fun for both of us. I will be thinking of you
 and will be with you in spirits on that day. In
 fact I am like that all of the time even now. My
 love for you spans all the distance between us
 and brings us together. Distance doesn't mean
 a damn thing to our love and it will grow more
 all of the time. I shall go to bed now and
 dream of you all night long. God Bless you
 Angel and loads of love. I'll be writing you
 real soon before you know it. I love you more
 than you know and miss you something

I went at the shop writing this to you from the muds about. Most of the crew has gone in town again to day. So I said I would guard the shop for I didn't want to go in. I went to have my money and wait until we arrive at our new base so I can buy you something there too! All I can say is that I love you more than you know. You are so damn wonderful and I want you so awful much. If you very know how much I do love you. To day I had your large picture in my arms and kissed you. How I do wish it was really you in the flesh instead of a picture. Darling, I miss you so damn much and want you more than you know. Soon you will be able to see how much I do love you by my actions of wonderful love making etc. I will be home with you before you know it. So just ^{say} ~~say~~ ⁱⁿ thanks.

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Do you realize that in two more days we have been in this war for two whole years. Do you recall the Sunday we learned about the war in my little radio? Johanna and Sis was with us on that day and we were riding about in my car. This time last year I was in the Cadets and a under classman in Preflight school. I was looking forward to our coming marriage. Today ^{10 months} ago, there was the day after our marriage and we had a man in the winter hotel. Remember how much damn fun we had? I mean while we were still back at Sweet City or even Harper. At least we were with each other in that place too. I would give anything to be able to have this Christ mass with you. It has been two years since we had our first Christ mass day together. I asked you to go steady the night before and we were so damn happy. We will have our Christ mass, the day I come home to you for keeps. Damn, I run do miss you an awful lot and would give any thing to have you in my arms this very moment. I want you so damn much and can't wait until I can make love to you again. As you know, you are my whole life and the only thing I care about in this world would be to day.

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Last nite, four of us laid in our bunks and talked all nite until 4 am this morning. in up here. You would have gotten rich as hell
if you did see them. We have no idea of how clean


today we are living in the States. You have to

Mind you I'm not compaining but just letting you know we don't have it as damn bad for the food is excellent. In fact, even better what we was getting on board back home. All I can say is that I love you more than you know and want you now. Truly awful. I would give anything to be able to make love to you this nite. I want to hold you in my arms and make velvet. Passionate love to you. I want to feel your wonderful body all pressed up against mine. I used to feel your fingers in my hair. I'm still doing it. I'm strayed lips kissing me. I'm still doing it. We are still here in this hole of hell. I do wish we would leave and finish up our trip. I'm tired of having dirty clothes to wear and would like a clean uniform for a change. Our barracks boy no A is in the ship but we can't get to them for there are arranged to balance the ship to a tee. I have one O.D. uniform, (cap was stolen) field jacket, flying cover all, four pair of socks and change of shorts out so I can get to them. Also my over coat in case we run into cold weather. I wish I could get to my other things and supplies. I sure could use all my other stuff. I do hope that I will see my B barracks boy again. That's the one that is being shipped by boat and it has all my personal stuff in it. I am sure do miss you more than careful and want you more than anything in the world. I didn't go to town today but the other day all went in. I have only gone in once and that is enough for me. I don't care about this town at all and you can see it on one trip. If you were here with me, I would like to show you around all of these places. You would get a big kick out of all the things I've seen. Honey, I don't know how my mail is getting to you from this dam place for the mail deal is all received up on this base like every thing else. Every thing in the P.X. is rationed and you have to have a card. So you can guess what kind of a place this is. Every one hates this place and I can't understand how the fellows

that are stationed here, keep from giving notes. I know I
would go nuts in a very short order. Your love is the
only thing that keeps me going. The fact you are
waiting for me at home gives me strength to do
anything so far away from you. This pain of being
away from you is hell and it is more than a poor
guy like me can bear. I can't wait until I come
home to you again. A lot of fellows like to get
away from their wives and all of that, but I want to
be with my little wife. You have no idea of how much
I miss you and want you. You are so wonderful and
beautiful. I adore you and am just plain mad
about you. As I keep on telling you, you are my
whole life and the only thing I care about. I know
you feel the same way that I do and want me
just as much. Darling, are you glad now that
you can wear panties all of the time and that I'm
not there to get mad at you for wearing them?
When I come home, you better throw all of them
away for you won't have any use for them at all.
Didn't we have a lot of fun making love and how
I used to tease you about it. I would give anything
to be with you right now as we could love and
make love all of that. I sure do miss all of that wonderful
love making and going to bed with you & I wish

 go and we are in the country where our final home is. Don't
 know how long we will stay in this field. So our trip is

 we can live right instead out of a field boy with no clean
 clothing. The trip was a lot of fun and I enjoyed each
 record of it. I will tell you all about it as soon as I
 can. Also, I will be able to tell you where I am in a
 couple of days. So be on the look out for the big letter and
 all of that. I will mail your Arabic knife as soon as I can.
~~I will buy you some more things as soon as I go to~~
~~town. All I can say, is that I love you and miss~~
 you more then you know. I have my old pipe going
 and you always liked me to smoke a pipe. I will do
 anything you say when I come home to you. Even do
 window shopping with you and will go willing in ladies
 stores to help you buy things. See how much I love
 you for you know how I use to act like all of those
 sort of things. Damn, I love you so awful much and
 can't wait until we can make love again. You are
 the only thing I care about and want.

Tell all your folks hello and to write as often as they can.
 I do find by hope, your grand father is quite well now and
 is up and about. Give him my regards and all of that.
 By the way, did you ever get that job you were talking
 about. Let me know all about it. Tell your sister
 Ellie & hope she catches her latest train this
 time. How bout Simey and her boy friend? Does she
 still have trouble with him, the darn fool F! I tell
 you to nite I met him at the village, that he didn't

 please don't worry about me in any way for I am ok
 and all of that. As I told you, this trip was one thing
 at all. Just pray real hard that soon this war is
 over and soon I will come home, & love you so damn
 much and want you more than you will ever
 realize until I come home and show you by
 actions. Do have fun and especially for both of us
 at Christ mas time. I will be with you then just
 as I am now. Well, I shall bid the ends now
 for no sleep last nite at all, flying all nite.

 you more than you know. Be good and keep you
 pretty little chin up and soon I shall be home



Good news at last. Peanuts! yes, I'm
dear old England and am I'm glad. I can't tell you what
part I'm in but you know where I am. I know you must
feel better now to know I am over here. This is the only place
in the world that is like the U.S.A. I am tickled to death to
be here and all of that. We aren't at war here as of yet but
will be in a few days. I suppose we will rest up a bit and
then move off. I don't know how long it will take for my
mail to reach you but shouldn't take more than a week,
I will keep on sending it all our mail to you for I know
you will want my mail as fast as possible. I can't wait
until I get to our base so I can get my mail from you.
I am just dying to hear from you and all of that. I
love you so damn much and want you more than you
know. I had to guard the ship today and tomorrow, hell
and I am going to try. We are in operations waiting
for a truck to go now. I will tell you all about what
goes on in this letter in the next one. It is damn
as hell here and just like Englands weather. This place
is full of mud too but I don't mind it for it is the
King's mud. I got a big kick out of all these blokes
the way they talk. We are over R.U.F. field and
talk to a lot of them. The chow is damn good here
and there. In fact the food is much better than we got
back in the States. You know how I like good grub
and all of that sort of things.

I just came back from town and we had a lot of dam fun.
This Country is really blacked out at nite and you can't find your
way about at nite with a dam. The moon was out tonight
and it help a whole lot. Walking, the streets are so damn
narrow here and everything moves just the opposite as
in the States. I mean traffic goes on the left hand
side and we are the right hand side. Their cars have
the wheels on the right and we on the left. So you
can see how funny it seems to me. When you
cross the street you have to watch out. Although, we
didn't see many cars running around. The ones
that were about, had black out dimmers on them
and you can't see them until they are on top of you.
First thing we did was to find a "pub" (beer joint)
and get away some ale and beer. Then don't ice
their beer and it is like warm. No ladies it all
go into the pubs in small towns like this one. We
had a lot of fun talking to the English and the
bar tender. We bought them beer and then bought
us some. You can always find bar flies no matter
where you go, in any country. Al and I didn't
get in town too late, about 8:30 pm we had to guard
the Beach all day. Most of the people I've met over
here think I'm English too because the way I look
and talk. Of course I spread on a tale that my
father was born in England and all of that. Another
reason, because I know all their customs and

I can understand the way their tails. I suppose I picked that up from all the books I read etc. I got along with them tip top. After a bit, we became hungry and wanted some chow. So we found a "shop" (all cafes, stores etc are called shops) and ate. We had "chips" (French Fries) and sandwiches. Also a cup of tea. We had more dam fun in that place. Honey, they sell chips over here like we sell popcorn at home. Every place you go there sell them and fish. Fish and chips to the English are like popcorn and hot dogs to us. Of course you know the money is different and now how to know the way to use their money.

English Penny = 2 cents (USA)	1 lb = 4.035	
1 shilling = 20¢	3 pence = 5¢	6 pence = 10¢
Half crown = 50¢ etc.	So I know what the deal is.	

They have a lot of other change too. I will make a list if it and will send it to you. I find this country very interesting Country. I do wish you were here so we could see all these wonderful things. I want to take you on a trip and show you all this when I come home. I will tell you all about each little thing I find out about the English and the things I do. I know you will be very interested in all this. I will be your eyes and will relate to you all the things I do and see. Honey, you may think I'm having a

lot of fun and don't miss you. You are worry
Angel! I miss you so dear much and can't stand
this being away from you like this. You are in
my mind all of the time and never leave it for one
fraction of a second. I may do these things to keep
from giving nuts and all that sort of thing.
I love you so dear much and want you more
than ever. You have no idea of how much I miss
you and want you. I want to come home to
you right now and would give anything to be
with you. I don't like this being away from you
one bit. War is hell and especially on menied
couples like us. I want you home and here.
My whole body aches out for the want of you
love and careness. You have no idea of how I long
for you. Just being in a few short minutes and
I will be home with you. Darling, they claim that
mail is much faster than any other mail.
I shall write you both each day after we get to
our final home. You let me know which is the
fastest etc. I shall always write you long
letters and you do the same. I want to to
catch the morning mail so I will close for now.
I shall see you in my dreams in a few minutes.



is over with. I was damn glad to see Ralph and especially
Ed. I hasn't seen the office as of yet for just got here
this afternoon. I will let you know all about what it
looks like etc. Each one of us has a certain job to do
and I don't know what mine is as of yet. Hope that it
is a good one etc. Darling, I very bad one letter here
waiting for me and it was from Mom, forwarded
from Lincoln. I didn't have a one from you and
some thought I would have some. I suppose it will
catch up with me in a few days and I do hope so. Anyway,
I have a new A.P.O # 634 and we shall use more. That
is the one I will have from now on out. We will be
at this time I suppose as long we are here. So you
can send me anything there etc. By the way, I can
use some more reading material, Chester fields,
candy and gum. Sodas and candy are rationed
here and I can always use more. I brought up a
supply of face on the way here and there will last
until you send me some. We are allowed seven packages
and that is almost all I wrote in a week. But
it is always good to have some on hand. Also, send
me some stationary. Not the V-mail kind but
something like this. The Army furnishes the V-mail
kind. I wrote Mom a V-mail tonight and you

this regular kind. Let me know which one gets to you all first. I'll write you long letters like this one each day and will also write you V mail if it gets to you faster. I know you like long letters like I do, so will write them to you. You do the same by using both. I can't wait until I hear from you and all of that. I love you so damn much and want you more than you know. Mail will help me to keep in etc. So keep em coming and I will do the same. I wrote you a letter yesterday while I was guarding the ship. I'm damn glad that I don't have to pull plane guard any more. Darling, its' best that I only use one side of a sheet in case they should cut out part. You don't have to worry about them censoring your mail to me. All I can say is that I love you and want you more than you know. I'm so damn hungry for you times and love making. Don't you wish that I could crawl in bed with you tonight. I would give anything to be home with you. When I come home, we have an awful lot of love making to catch up on. I will never be able to make up for all this lost time and love. So be prepared for a hell of a lot of love making when I do come home which won't be long from now. Just hang on a little while and I will be back. I am so want you so awful much and can't wait until I can make love to you. You are my whole life and the only thing I care about in this whole damn world.

I don't know much about this place but I just got here. It is a rather large one and things are a bit spread out. The mess hall is nearer or just walls from here as every thing else is. I ate chow here for the first time to night and it wasn't no damn bad. I was hungry as a damn horse anyway and I'm still that way right now. I wish I could get away one of your meals again for these were no damn good. You practicing up in how to make a lot of new things for I shall be always hungry when I come home to you. I can't ever get enough to eat. Last nite, after I got off guard duty, I went in town for the main purpose of getting a damn good meal. I ate in about four damn places in town and if I were, went to a few pubs for beer. This beer can't compare to the good old Key beer and I sure do wish I could get a bottle of beer from home to taste. Drink me for me next time you have me. Well, I have my other bag and can get along until the B boy comes. Boy, I wish I had a nice ham burger right now and a coke. two things I haven't seen in a long time. Sure do miss those two things besides a lot of other American things. You have no idea how good they are to you can't have them.





Jim is target charts and in the things I used to do back in the States. They claim Jim a specialist in this line. I can't tell you all about my work etc but it is like the work I was doing when we were in the States. The office is about a mile away from our barracks and we have to walk back and forth each day. I got a pair of over shoes to take care of the mud. As you know, it is always a bit muddy over here and you have to keep your feet dry. So the over shoes come in handy. This is not a dam but here and I like it okay. Of course it isn't like home but will have to do for awhile. All I can say is that I love you and want you more than you know. I hope that you can read this okay for I have to use my knee again. Please send me a few things that I asked for I can use them. Also send me some things to read for I have time at nites to read now.

I just got back from taking a shave and washing up.
The wash room is a little away from the barracks and
run over there. No hot water over there, so I heated up a
bucket of water and lube it over with me. I like to shave
each day and always feel better after a good hot shave.
Some of the guys don't shave each day and let their
beards grow a day or two. I don't like that one bit and
always like to lube half way decent. Damn, it is just
about time to hit the lights out and go to bed. They have
a black out here all the time and it is blacber than hell
outside. We have covers for the window and all of that.
I have two flash lights and they come in handy at nites.
We can't go to town here as of yet but will later on. We
are suppose to get a 24 hour pass each week besides
other passes. Every three months, we are suppose to get
a 8 day pass though. Don't know for sure about this
and will let you know more about this later on. I do
hope we get the 8 days for you could get away from
the damn army for awhile anyway. Honey, I have to go to
bed now and will try to finish this up in the morning
if I can't will mail it any way as is. I love you so
dam much and want you more than you know. I have
your large picture hanging right above my bed and
you are looking down on me. So I shall hit the sack and
shall dream of you all nite long and will make love to you.



Hello, you red sweet thing. Do you know that I'm so damn much in love with you and want you more than it is possible. Today I got a letter and a card from Mom, also one from Sis in New Haven. No mail from my little wife though. I hate for a day to go by without any mail from you. This makes the second day with no mail from you. I do hope you are getting just loads of mail from me and that you get at least one each day. All I can say is that I want plenty of mail from you and can't wait until it comes. I love you so awful much and just cant stand the thought of not being here to you. Do you miss me very much? I don't see how I've survived and how I shall carry on without you. The only thing that is with while about me is that you are my wife. I still can't understand how I was lucky enough to catch you. Thanks again for saying yes that Feb²⁰ day. I shall never forget that day for it was the day I began to live. You will never know how happy you've made me. I live you more now than I did even yesterday. My love for you is active no matter where or how far we are apart. Each nite, before I go to sleep, I make love to you in my mind and then I dream about it all nite long.

Some of these dreams are so real that it's a wonder you don't feel them too! Each night I do this and each time... it makes me want you more. Do you think and dream like this very often. All I can say is we the Boy Scout saying, "Be Prepared".

Today, I was amblying along the road, nochantly as hell and along came a 2nd L voice with the wings of a bombardier proudly displayed on his puny chest. & gives him a snappy cut of the hoot, ~~salute~~ salute and breeze on by him. Suddenly, it dawned upon my untrained brain, that the said L & guss was one I've seen before. To my intense surprise, as I whistled alont, he was standing with open mouth graying upon my manly form. I yelled, "Hugh Francis, you old Son of a —". Yep! it was Hugh one of my X school chums at dear old St Xavier. You know Hugh and his brother Billy Francis who is a escape fighter pilot in the U.S.N.  go in a liberty pass (6 hours) some nite and may go
 in Christmas nite. The fellows say it is blacker than
 a coal mine in Penn., at nite time. I really don't care
 about going in just to see the sights and put on the feed
 bag. I do want to go to London and see the sights. I
 will tell you all about it. I am I love you so awful
 much and want you more than you know. I know
 that you feel the same way as I do and want me as
 much as I want you. Boys, I can't wait until I see you.

Sis wrote that she was going to call you up to eat
 down town with you. Did she and did you have fun?
 I wish I could take you out and all of that sort of
 thing. When I come home, we shall just be in one
 big money go round and do nothing but live, have
 fun and more fun. Uncle Samp, he will give us \$300
 bucks the day we are promoted to a civilian. 300
 green backs will buy us a lot of fun and good times.
 So, I assure you we will have one hell of a time when
 this unbearable war is over. Pray real hard that it
 will end as fast as possible. I want you no soon
 much and can't wait until I can get my hands
 on you. I want to kiss you until your ears full off
 and your hair stands on end. I will hug you no soon
 tight that your ribs will break and pop. You just
 wait and see how violent I shall be. As I said
 before, Be Prepared for some powerful love making.
 Darling, you know that greasy jerk at Scibner's
 that you thought was nice looking. Well, the same
 jerk is in my barracks and is a K.P. pusher. They
 only make chips so that kind of work and he is a
 drip of the first water. Peanuts, what is Mary's husband
 name and what Syc is he in. I would like to know
 and all of that. I do hope you have sent the things
 I asked for by now and especially the writing paper.


