tonight. I'm a bit browned off about this  
mail situation and if I was a drinking man  
Well! I know that you write me each day  
and I have mail on the way. I get so damn  
blue when all the other fellows get mail  
and jabs eyes, and I have none. Honest,  
you have no idea of what a letter from you  
means to me and what it does to my morale.  
All I can say is that I want mail and  
my real hard fruit. Peanuts, that soldier  
who is so damn crazy about you is twice  
as much in love with you now. I'm just  
wild about you and adore you more than  
it is possible. If you only knew how much  
I love you and want you. I would give  
any thing to be with you right now.


Bug! was a dead duck this morning when I got off from work. I was on duty 24 hours and you can guess how I felt. I couldn't hardly walk to the benches and the mess hall. I slept all day long until 4:30 this afternoon. I would still be asleep if the pangs of hunger hadn't pained my gut. I got up and shaved the two day bush off of my face. Dick is on a Squadron detail tomorrow and I think it is mixing Cement etc. I don't know when I will catch it and do hope that I never do have it. Honey, do you have the photo I sent you last night? They and all the other combat crews eat and  
sleep in a different rate than we do. Of course  
I see them all at the briefing and when they  
go to school. Now, I will help to give lectures  
to them on aircraft identification. When you  
do this sort of work, you help out in the office  
or any other places. I will help in the news paper  
work and in the office (paperwork) I never  
do like this neither. I don't like the idea of being  
locked up in a small stuffy room. I like this  
work that I'm now doing first it is more up  
my alley. You know how I am about planes  
and all of that. I still have high hopes to get  
back in the Cadets and shall look into this  
London deal later on. I shall wait and see  
what goes etc. It may be a good idea to stay

as I am. I will let you know later on what the deal is. I would like to fly again and all of that. I know you would rather that I didn't but it is something I just have to do. When I come home I will keep on flying and one day will own my own Crate. Do you mind? Henry you should get a book of the characters in their books. They're having a big argument about civilian dues now. I have to chime in every once in awhile about my experience as a clothing sales man and to settle some of the disputes. You know how I am about clothing and how much I know about it. One of the fellows is a old 2nd Suster and we are tearing the hell out of him. Some of them guys have a mouth on them that would make the dead. We argue about any damn thing to pass the time away. Sometimes it goes on well into the nite. I'm always in the middle of it,

From soup to nuts. and then back. Darling we  
are supposed to receive a new Air force patch  
now with the no of the Air Force we are in. I will  
take mine off for you sew it on. So there it  
will stay. As I told you, I wear the hell out

I could be with you right now. I can't wait  
until I'm home with you for keeps. I know  
you want me as much as I want you. Honey,  
I know it is hard on you not going out  
with young people and all of that. Just make  
the best of it and you will have fun. I will  
make this all up when I come home to you.  
Honey, what is the favorite movie now and  
the best seller. Send me some good books  
and I do mean good. nice juicy ones etc.  
How is St X. doing in the basketball this year?  
I suppose they are tops again this year as  
they are always are.

real soon and before you know it.



No letter today. I've waited since dawn & of etc. I am pined off about this damn mail and wonder what the hell goes. Some of the guys get some mail each day but I receive none. I suppose that I'm the forgotten men and no further. I'm only kidding but know you write me each day. I'll just have to wait for my boat to dock. It is hard as hell not to be blue about this mail but I'm doing my best not to get down in the dumps. I shall keep my chin up and I know that my mail is on the way. I'm so damn worn out again tonight and with my old butt off today. I ache all over from head to foot. We really put out the work now and no fooling around. I like to work for where you can see the results and it to go into action instead of theory. You like to work and all done more than this fast for we want to end this damn war as soon as hell.

This afternoon Sgt Dowdry and I gave a lecture to the Crews on planes. Our officer is suppose to do this and we to help him such as running the movie machine etc. Can't work all night long so we had to do it our self. I like to do more than my little part for I know it helps to bring about the end of this damn war and my home coming to you. Honey, I hope you can read this awful damn writing for have to hurry. I didn't get off to late tonight and I have to shave and clean up. I don't have time to do much of anything for myself anymore. But this is war and we have to do our part. I do wish I could get some mail from home and all of that. I love you so damn much and want you more than you know. Honest, I miss you more and more each day. You are my whole life and the only thing I care about. Nothing & do holds my interest but you. I want you more than you know and love you more and more.

Today Dick was on Squadron detail and had a easy job of tending two fires. He sat in his ~~bed~~ beside most of the time. Ralph is on the job tomorrow and I will move them bks by pull it the next day. Honey, I have find hopes for another stripe and am pray ing like hell for it. You do the same thing. A couple of guys have been broken in S-2 for coming late to work one day. Then Sgt. S. turned them into the Captains and he had no alternative but to burst them to Pts. Both were Cpl's like myself. I sure hate a job who would turn in his men like that. I would just lay for him in the black out some nite, you know how I am when I get mad as hell. Sometimes I get a hell of a temper up and sound off. You know, we never had one fight as of yet? I know that we won't have any for we both agree and like the same things. That is why we got married and with some one you live and a dose.





Darling, do you know its about 2 months now since I last made love to you. Damn, that is a long time and I do miss you so awful much. You have no idea of how I miss you and long for you. I would give anything to be with you tonight. Angel, please excuse this writing for we are flying at about 11,000 ft and it is a bit rough up here today. We are bouncing about something awful and I can't hardly write as you can plainly see. I think I'll all wait until we go down a little lower and then I'll finish this letter. Well we are down now and I have to guard the ship again tonight with Al Woodward. We take it by turns now for 12 hours. He sleeps awhile and I stay awake etc. So its not so damn bad after all. We sure did have a long trip this time again and we were all just about worn out when we landed. I slept most of the trip but still it was rough. Its a lot of fun to land at different places and see strange sights that you read about or see in the movies. I never dreamed that such places were real and so forth. I do wish you could see these places too. You would like to see them too just like I do. Al just came back from China so I think he will go to eat in a second too. He said this is one hell of a place and we have tents to sleep in. I don't care for I have the ship to sleep in tonight. I will go to China and clean up now.

I just got back and all was right about this damn place. It is after dark now and I am in the radio compartment of the Peach, writing this by flash light. Bon, what a damn place this is. You have to eat out of your mess kit and live in a damn open tent. I wanted to shave and washing but couldn't find the latrine. So I have a days growth of bush on my face and I will look like a hunk of David fellow in the morning. I don't give a damn though for I don't care about a thing since you went away and I left the U.S.A. Well, yesterday at our last stop, we had games to town and more damn fun. I can't tell you just as if it where it was but it was over there to me. I didn't believe there were such places until I saw them with my own eyes. I'll have just bunches of tales to tell you when I come home. You will be all ears for months to come. Just wait and see. When we reach our final home, if I can, I will relate to you some of my so called adventures. You will laugh and wait to hear them. Last nite in town, Al, Glen and myself ran into two swell English Sgts in their English R.C.F. They were gunners in a Sunderland, a English Flying Boat. We met them in a bar about 5:30 and spent the rest of the nite with them. We had some damn fun comparing customs with them. We ~~had~~ smoked their English Cigarettes and then smoked ours. I bet we drank 6 glasses of wine and no telling how much beer we drank. When we had to leave for the boat the two English lads were drunker than hell. I was feeling good and so were the other two gunners but we drank the Jimmies under the so called table. They are two of the nice and best fellas I ever met.


Darling, not sending cards (3)

class is chaps etc. I bet you couldn't understand  
the way they talked. We were supposed to meet them  
again tonight if we were still there. They didn't want  
us to leave at all. They were on a 7 day leave and  
didn't have anything to do but drink their leave out.  
We never did give them a damn good start. They trusted  
our Air Force and we trusted theirs. I made a toast  
to the King and they jibber well liked that. I bet  
we trusted every famous man in each of our two  
countries. Wish you could of met them. They took a  
lot more to me for I'm part English and could talk

Please write to me each day like I do you. I don't know how long it takes my mail to reach you but I'm sending it all air mail. Well, it's my turn to stand guard so I will close until I come back. Al wants to write his wife too and I will give him some of my paper and pen. I don't know if you've ever seen Al Woodward or not but I know he spoke to us while we were together in the P.T. at Scranton. He is a medic.

Just finished my rounds of the ship and now have time to finish this up to you. Darling, I sincerely hope you are having fun and looking forward to a joyful Christmas. I know that you will feel bad at ~~time~~ tide because of my being so far away from home. Do not feel bad and have a damn good time for the two of us. I will feel much better to know things are happy and the same at home. So do it for me. Angel, I will be with you in spirit and all of that sort of thing. Do not worry about me for I shall have some sort of Christmas where ever I may be. My Christmas will be the day I come home to you to stay and that won't be long now. Damn, I love you so fucking much and would give anything to have some of your fascinating love making. Poor little old Oscar is lost and don't know what to say any more, I think he will perish but will come to life when (you know) he hits home. Peanuts, I do miss you more than words can express and want you more than you know. I love you awful and want you more than you know. I love you more ~~now~~ now than I did yesterday, a month ago, etc. Just hang on until I come home to you real soon. I still have that Cadet deal in mind and will see what the score is. Will let you know more about this later when I find out. Pray real hard that I can get back in and come home to you.

Have you gone over to Morris for a few days? I can't wait to catch up on all of the latest news from home. Please keep me informed of what goes on around the red house town etc. Sweet news, if you go up to Carrie's drink me for me. I sure could use some of that good old Ky. brew. Tell all of the folks hello for me and give them my love. Especially your sister Catharine. I do hope your Grand father is much better now and I am anxiously awaiting news of his recovery. That is the first one I've heard so far  
and will tell you all the ones I do

 love. Tell all the folks hello and to



Here goes the 2nd letter I will

dam glad that you said yes. The next year  
I gave you a watch and we went to a

with you. Christmas 41, I gave you a

it won't be no dam bad after all. I love  
you no dam much and want you

see you tomorrow and the gift's  
you receive. I wish I had a gift for you  
under that tree. I suppose the hundred  
you is there by now and that will have to  
be your gift until I go to town. Darling,  
you ask if I would rather have a wedding

would rather have the ring and my ring  
size is about 8 or 7. Ed has one and  
a lot of the other married girls two. But  
please don't spend all of your dough in me.  
Honey, I will send you some dough as  
soon as I am paid this month. I should  
get about 50 bucks this month and  
will need about 20 for myself. I have  
20 in my pocket right now and I've only  
spent a couple bucks since I've been here.  
All my money is English and they say  
off in the flinig money. When you wire

worry home, if course they change  
it back to American green backs.  
Darling, I miss you so dear much and  
want you more than it is possible.  
Woe is hell! Oh! how I wish I could  
see you to night. I would like to see all  
the pretty gifts under the tree and to  
sink my teeth into all the wonderful  
food. Sit around, drinking highballs  
and having fun. I just can't talk about  
these wonderful things. Home and you  
seems so far away to night. This letter  
may sound a little blue to you and  
the truth is that I am blue. Christmas  
always did mean so much to me  
and especially after we met. Oh! if I  
could only see you this nite and could

to you. The greatest and the best gift I've ever received was the day you became my wife. That was my Christmas day and the best I ever had. Darling, some of the things received packages from home and are passing around the fruit cake etc. Some have a bit of Christmas after all. I know that you are thinking of me right this minute. Of course it is still day time in Louisville. It is 10:30 here and it must be almost 4:30 pm at home. There is almost a four hours difference in the time. My water is hot now so I will shave and clean up. Finish this after I clean up.

Just shaved and cleaned up. It is now  
11:30 and we have the radio in the barracks  
turned in to some jazz. It is going forth

Christmas Songs. Henry, I've written  
you so much tonight that my hand

No mail from you today  
but a V-mail from Aunt Mary. Today was  
the big day of the year and all of that. I sure  
did think of you real hard all day long and  
missed you run thing awful. This morning  
at mass, I felt so damn blue and had to  
hold back the flood of tears. Our Chapel  
is a round sheet metal building that  
the RAF is so fond of. It also serves as the  
shub. Some one decorated it with holly  
and they had a tree up too. The flowers  
covered with mud from our boots. They  
have plain old wooden benches in it etc.  
But this morning, the place was like

We had to work right in for the war knows no off days. There is one job in our barracks that is just as a gig. We all tear the hell out of him about being so damn fat. He is a good natured guy like most fat guys are. Honey, you should hear this guy in the raids who thinks he is the English version of Bob Hope. This English humor kills me and the way they murder our songs. The only way that we can appreciate them are in records. Then play American records for the G.I.'s we have. I'm damn glad that we have a radio in the barracks. Never seen a English man for desertions to some place.

They will tell you a whole bunch of stuff and then will say (every damn time) "you can't miss it." And I'll be darn if you can find it. Honey, the boys over here go in for pinups in a big way. The barracks is just about jammed with females now make it. I draw a lot of them for the fellows. Another fellow in the barracks can really draw and he makes me look like a damn amateur. I wish I could sketch as half as good as he can. Next time I get in the mood, I will draw you a damn good picture. By the way, did you ever get those photos made for me? Remember how long I had to wait last time for you to have your pictures made? I can never get enough of them. Honey, we have a projector that flashes photos in a screen and each day, I put

Your photos in the machine and  
blow them up to 10 times life size.  
I like to do that you know. I wish it  
was really you in the flesh. Aunt Mary  
said that you and Mum were not to  
see her. Also that you looked as if you  
missed me so damn much. Please don't

and all of that, but we have our laughs

you my little wife and lots of love.




He sleeps underneath of me. Honey, all I

this month this pay roll. I will be paid  
in a special number and will be paid  
for Nov and Dec on it. So I won't be  
paid off until about the 3rd of Dec. Then  
I will send you some dough home to you.  
So I am the low ball for a wire with  
dough around the 10th of Jan. I don't  
need any money so I will send it to  
you. Save it and we can use when I  
come home. We want to have one hell  
of a good time and it will go on for days.  
I can't wait until I can get my  
Icem. I will do no thing but  
hands on you. We will do no thing but  
live for days and days. No kidding, we  
will take a honey moon and go some  
place. Where ever you want to go will  
be okay with me. I know you want to  
be alone with me so we will go away  
on a trip. May be not right away but  
will be all worn out etc and will need a  
few days rest. I'm not kidding when  
I say it will all be over soon. I don't  
know just it will be, but not long.

I also got a anniversary Card from you  
to day. You are so thought ful and  
sweet. I would like to send you Cards  
and all of that but you know how it  
is over here. There is a lot of things I  
would like to send you but no can find.  
When I come home, I went to take you  
out on a buying spree. We will do nothing  
but have fun and live. So kick yourself  
up for me hell of a time. I was glad to  
hear that you spend a few days over home  
each week. I know you feel much closer  
to me when you sleep in my bed. I never  
do with I could crawl in bed with you  
like I use to do. We did have so much  
fun and I can't wait until we take up  
where we ~~were~~ left off. I miss you more  
and more each day. Each day that goes  
by, I know it is a day closer to being  
with you. That is the only thing that keeps  
me going each day. It is painful as  
hell to be away from you like this and  
I want to end it as soon as possible.

have to heat my own water each nite in  
order to shave and clean up. I have to shave  
each day or else I feel awful and not  
worth a damn. Some guys can let a big  
brush grow on their faces but not I.


I think that we have to move out of this
