

Readjustment of
College hours.

State College, Tex., 14th March, 1908.

The faculty met in the president's room in called session at 4 P.M.
Pres. Patterson, Maj. Burt, Profs. Mackenzie, Brooks, Pusey, Patterson, Kastle,
Pryor, Miller, Anderson and White were present.

President Patterson announced that the meeting had been called at the instance
of Maj. Burt who stated that the object of the meeting was to consider some
change in hours for College work. He then moved 1st that morning college work begin
at 8 A.M. and terminate at 12:30 P.M., 2^d that dinner hour extend from 12:30 to 1:30,
3^d that drill hour begin from 1:30 to 2:30 P.M., 4th that the period for laboratory work
extend from 2:30 to 4:30. Maj. Burt stated that the object of the change contemplated
was to allow a full hour, instead of thirty minutes, for dinner and to have drill
follow, rather than precede dinner. Maj. Burt's motion was seconded by Prof. Patterson.
After some discussion Prof. Anderson moved to amend the motion so as to have labora-
tory work begin at 1:30 and drill at 3:30, the object of the amendment being to place
drill and all other athletic work after classroom work. The amendment
was fully discussed, after being seconded by Prof. Kastle, and was adopted,
Profs. Brooks, Anderson, Kastle, Pusey, Pryor, Miller and White voting for and
Maj. Burt and Profs. Mackenzie and Patterson against the amended resolution.
Prof. Patterson moved that all academy students be excused from drill. Prof. Kastle
said he would be glad to second this motion but that he thought the faculty
had no authority to excuse students from drill. Pres. Patterson then stated
that the faculty had no authority to change the drill hour ^{having been} it ^{has} been fixed
by the Board of Trustees. On motion the faculty adjourned. Jas. K. White
