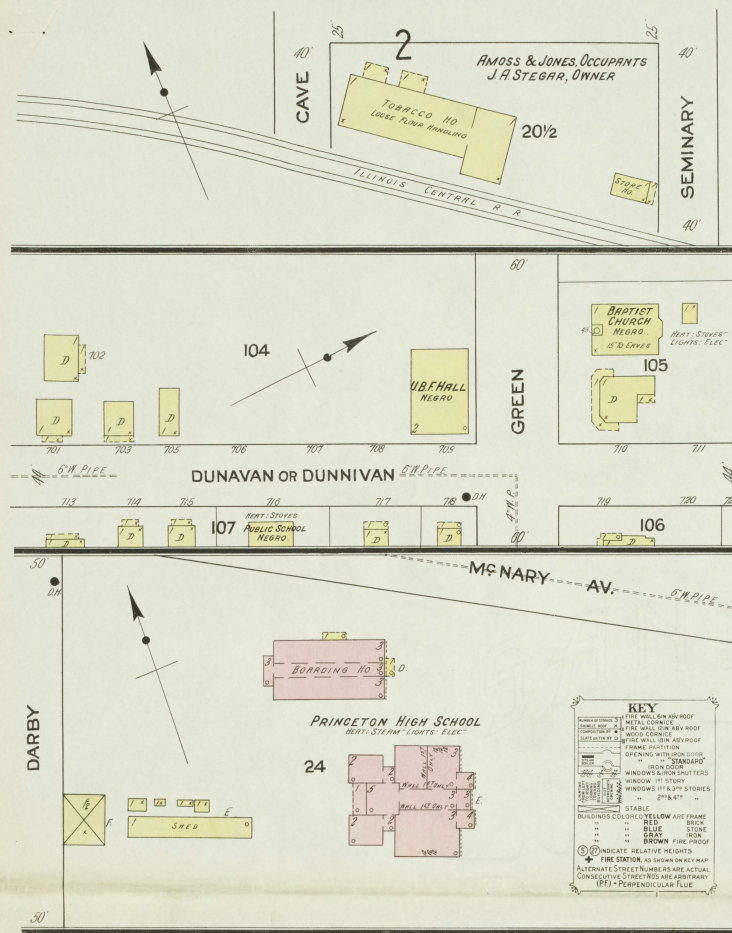


WATER FACILITIES
Water works built in 1905 & owned by town. Direct pumping system. Water taken from 6' wells by air lift & also from underground stream by electric motor to a 250,000 gal. reservoir at pumping station. Water pumped from reservoir direct to mains by 24" open duplex pumps, size 6" dia. with a capacity of 150,000 gals per 24 hrs. or 520 gal per min. Domestic pressure 40 to 60 lbs per sq in. Fire pressure 100 to 200 lbs per sq in. Daily consumption not known. 7 1/2 miles of cast iron water pipe, 4" to 8" size. 83 double hydr.

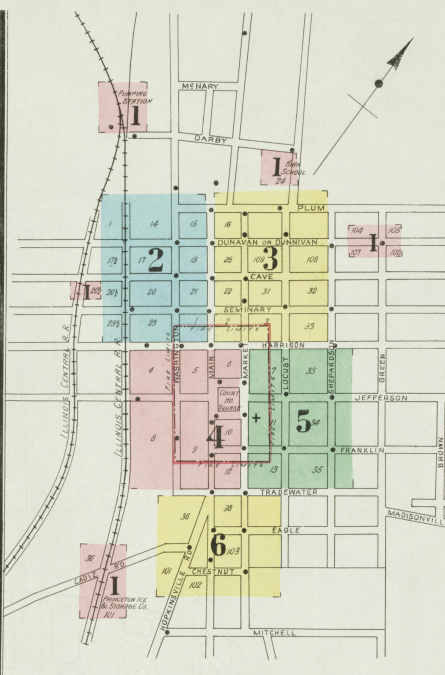
FIRE DEPT.

Public lights: electric.



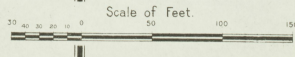
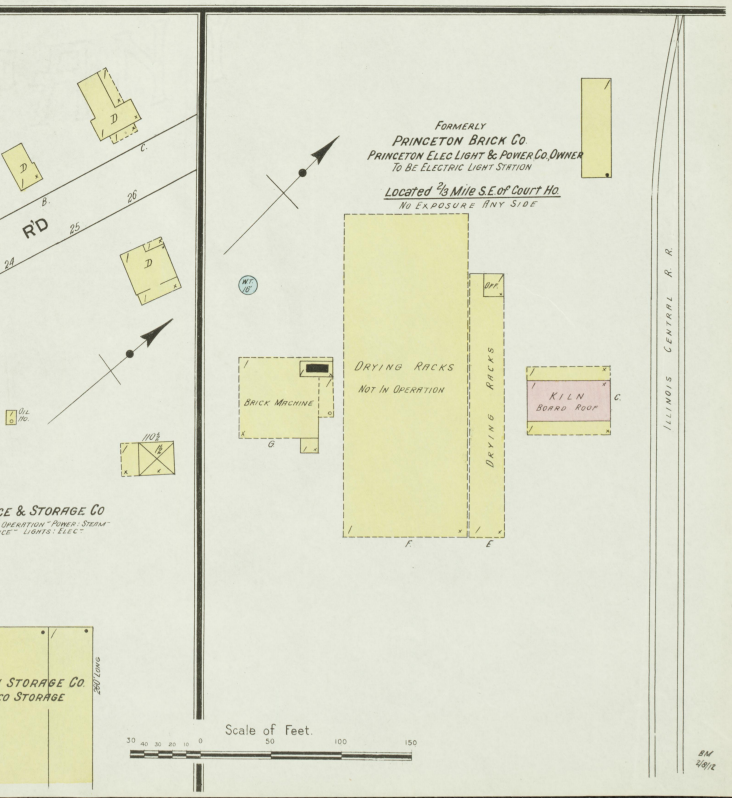
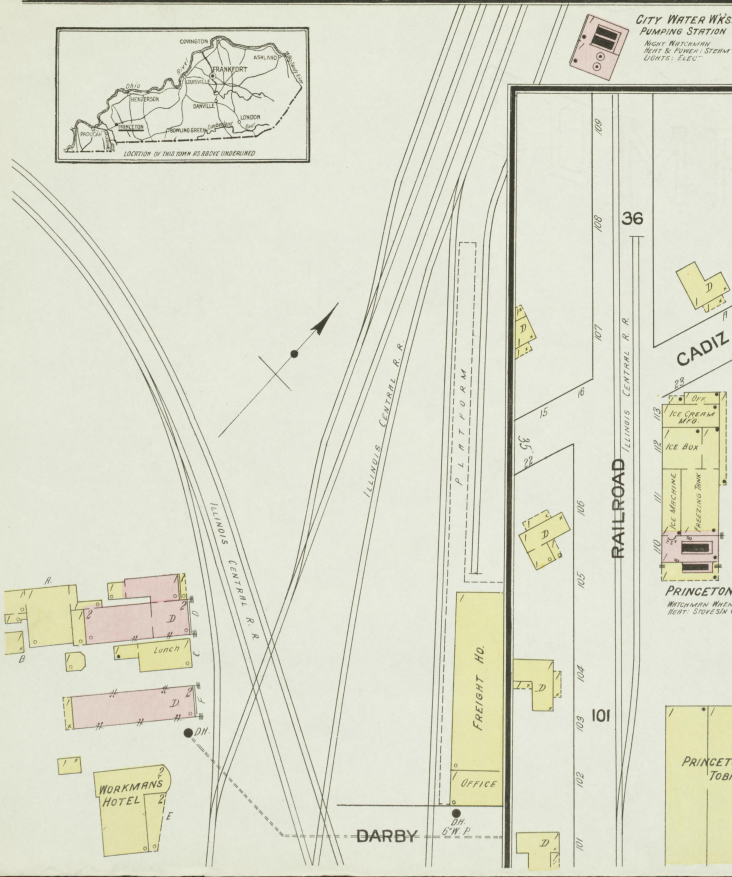
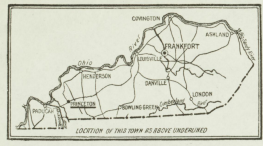
