

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#### PREFACE

The Inventory of Federal Archives in the States is one of the products of the work of the Survey of Federal Archives, which operated as a nation-wide project of the Works Progress Administration from January 1, 1936 to June 30, 1937, and has been continued in Kentucky since that date as a state project of that Administration.

The plan for the organization of the Inventory is as follows: Series I consists of reports on the administration of the Survey, acknowledgments, and general discussions of the location, condition, and content of federal archives in the states. Succeeding series contain the detailed information secured by workers of the Survey, in inventory form, a separate series number being assigned to each of the executive departments (except the Department of State) and other major units of the Federal Government. Within each series No. 1 is a general introduction to the field organization and records of the governmental agency concerned; the succeeding numbers contain the inventory proper, separate numbers being assigned to each state in alphabetical order. Thus, in each series, the inventory for Alabama is No. 2, that for Arizona No. 3, that for Arkansas No. 4, etc.

For each local office information regarding each series, or unit of related records, is presented in the following order: title, inclusive dates ("to date" indicating an open file at the time the information was secured), general description of informational content, description of the system of filing or indexing (if any), a statement of frequency and purpose of use, form of the record itself (bound volumes, shoots in folders, etc.), linear footago, doscription of the containers, physical condition of the records (not stated if satisfactory), location by room number or other identifying information, and finally, the number of the Form 58SA on which this information was originally recorded by a Survey worker and from which it was abstracted for the Inventory. This form is on file in The National Archives. When it contains substantial information on addonda sheets which has not been included in the mimoographod abstract, indication of this is given by use of the reforence "See addenda."

In Kentucky the work of the Survey was undertaken by Judge Samuel C. Williams, with Mr. John Wilson Townsend as his assistant, from its inception until October, 1936. Since that time Mr. Townsend has been in charge of the project. This inventory of the records of the Farm Credit Administration in Kentucky was prepared in the Louisville office of the Survey and was edited before final typing by Mr. Lewis J. Darter, Jr., of the Division of Agriculture Department Archives of The National Archives. It is reproduced in mimoegraphed form through the facilities of the Historical Records Survey.



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This office of the Farm Credit Administration was established at Louisville in 1933, with jurisdiction over District No. 4, comprising Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky, and Tennessee. The offices of the older units and those of the FCA, formerly in the old Federal Land Bank Building, moved to the present address in February 1935. The farm credit district office consists of the federal land bank, the federal intermediate credit bank, the production credit corporation, and a bank for cooperatives. The directors of the federal land bank are also ex-officio diroctors of these other banks. The general agent, nominated by the governor of the FCA, coordinates and administers the services of the bank. The federal land bank acts as the agent for the federal farm mortgago corporation. The federal intermediate credit bank was established at Louisville in 1923. It was under the direction of a manager, named by the federal land bank, until 1933 when its own officials were assigned to it under FCA. The records of the production credit corporation are filed with those of the intermediate credit bank. The fedoral land bank was established in 1917 and the federal mortgage corporation on Jan. 31, 1934. Records of the FFMC and the FLB are very closely related and many are filed together; others are distinguished and segregated in the FFMC office. The farm loan registrar's office was established under the jurisdiction of the land bank in 1917. The functions of this office are to record and hold in safe keeping all notes and mortgages posted with the various agencies of the FCA as cellateral for loans granted by thom.


