It is further ordered that the Treasurer ~~turn over~~
to J. B. Bowman whatever balance of the income from
the slate pens may remain after paying the salaries
of the Faculty of the A & M College to be used by
him in paying the other expenses of conducting
the A & M College and paying the student labor
which expenses and payment of students labor
J. B. Bowman assumes to pay in full. It is
also agreed that the Treasurer shall give Regent ~~Bowman~~
credit for the whole amount of matriculation fees of
the A & M College; and in consideration thereof Regent
Bowman agrees to pay all the incidental expenses of
conducting the A & M College and of keeping the farm
and buildings in repair and that it is agreed that the
University is to be at no expense whatever for repairs to the
fencing ^{farm} buildings or any ~~other~~ expenses of conducting
~~the farm~~ ^{The farm & buildings} to be returned in as good condition
as when the same begins.

The houses now rented to the Professors of the A & M Coll^y
are not included in this arrangement.

It is further ordered that the Hemp crop now on the
farm, shall be broken out and sold by J. B. Bowman and
after deducting the expenses of sale, treating the hemp J. B.

Brownman is to account to the Treasurer of the University for
the net proceeds of the hemp crop to be settled with the
Treasurer when his last account matures. — The other
crops on the place are to be taken charge of by J. B.
Brownman and the same amount returned by him ~~on or~~
before the 20th day of October 1877. An inventory of the
stock, farming implements, ~~etc.~~ other than the
hemp is to be taken and filed with the Specie-line
Committee.

The Board of Curators at its last annual meeting having referred to the Executive Committee the report of the Committee on the Farm with instructions to rent out the farm, and the difficulties growing out of the payment of Student labor being serious, and complicated; at the urgent request of a majority of the Committee Agent L. B. Bowman has consented to rent the farm and farm stocks & implements and assume all the obligations of working and paying the Student labor and all other expenses of running the farm on the following terms and conditions viz
~~and heretofore unexecuted~~

The farm, except the grain land which is now under rent to Summons Brothers of New York through I checked their Agent until the first day of April 1877, to be leased to L. B. Bowman from the first of October 1876 to the first day of October 1877 together with all the farming implements & farm stocks, and all the grain land now rented to Summons ^{by his co} April 1877 when Summons leave ^{is required} L. B. Bowman to the first day of April 1878, the rent for the whole Estate to be Two Thousand Dollars, for the

terms before mentioned. — One half of the rent
to be paid on the first day of April 1877 and the
other half on the first day of October 1877, for
which the lessee is to execute his two negotiable
notes payable to the treasurer of the University.

It is further ordered that the ~~maximum~~ rate
of Student labor to be paid by J. B. Brown or for
Student shall not exceed seven cents per hour
nor the maximum five cents per hour.

It is further ordered that any excess of
the income on the State Grant over and above paying
the salaries of the Professors of the Attm College
~~shall all expenses of conducting said College shall~~
~~be used in paying the Student labor and other~~
~~other expenses of conducting the Attm College which J. B. Brown~~
~~there shall have the right to use the same for~~
~~any amount to pay in full~~
~~that professor, and the student after paying the~~
~~salaries of the professors of the Attm College and~~
~~other necessary expenses of the College, shall~~
~~leave over whatever balance may remain to~~
~~the board; it is understood being that the State~~
~~grant shall be appropriated solely to the payment~~
~~of conducting the Attm College the Student labor~~
