FOREWORD

In issuing this bulletin, listing all elementary schools of the state for the school-year 1964-65, I have reviewed with much interest the great improvement taking place in the area of elementary education. The progress is remarkable and I want to commend highly all of those who have worked to bring about this progress.

Elementary schools of eight or more teachers are classified in relation to a STANDARD SCHOOL. Appropriate standards and criteria are written into the regulations for accrediting elementary schools adopted by the State Board of Education. It is significant to note the number of schools achieving the standard rating compared with the number last year and the gradual increase in this number for the five-year period since 1960. Yet with this progress much remains to be done. Therefore, I want to impress on all personnel engaged in the improvement of elementary education to proceed forward toward, not only meeting the minimum requirements for a standard school, but to go far beyond to a high quality diversified program.

I trust this bulletin will be helpful.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1964-65

There were 1,004 elementary schools accredited by the State Board of Education during the school year 1964-65. Of this number 633 were under the control of the county school districts and 236 were under the control of the independent districts. Seventeen (17) were State, Federal, or Regional schools and 118 were private schools. As will be seen, there was a variety of organizations according to the grades included in the type of organization. By far, the greatest number of organizations conform to a 1-8 type of organization or a 1-6 organization. Of these 565 were organizations offering a program from one through the eighth grade and 312 offered a program from one to six grades making a total of 877 schools out of 1,004.

Table I below shows the number of accredited elementary schools classified according to the type of control for five years from 1960-65.

The total number of elementary schools operating in Kentucky including all of the elementary schools of seven teachers and below as well as the 1,004 accredited schools, numbered 2,183 schools. Of this number, there were 563 one-teacher schools compared to 704 one-teacher schools last year. Comparison of the schools of other sizes can be seen by study of the summary information included in the back of this book.

The number of pupils enrolled in the accredited elementary schools continues to grow. This year there were 442,697 pupils enrolled in these schools for the year. Of this number 271,789 were in the schools under the control of the county school districts, and

In all of the elementary schools there was a total staff of 16,998 teachers, supervisors, principals, and other special instructional personnel serving during the school year of 1964-65. Of this number 16,235 or approximately 95 per cent were serving in the schools of eight or more teachers or schools accredited by the State Board of Education. There is indication that the professional staff is growing not only in quantity but in quality as well. During the school year of 1964-65, 88 per cent of the total staff had a quality of training of a Bachelor's Degree plus 16½ semester hours. This was an increase of 4 per cent over the previous year and over 25 per cent in five years from 1960-61 to 1964-65.

Table IV below gives the median prepared of all elementary school personnel for a fifteen year period from 1950-65.

The trend in the development of the elementary schools throughout the state is towards the larger elementary school unit in order to make it practical to offer an effective program of education.

Table V following shows the number of elementary schools accredited for the school year of 1964-65 compared with the school year of 1959-60, classified according to size.

It will be seen from a study of Table V that the schools of 16 teachers and below, have decreased in number from 616 to 611 during the six-year period while the schools of 17 teachers and above have increased from 248 to 393.
