

State University, Monday June 1, 1908.

Monday morning the faculty met in the president's room at 9 A.M. After an informal discussion, it was moved by Dr. Pryor, seconded by Professor Noe, that this faculty recommend to the Board of Trustees that Judge William Thornton Lafferty be given the honorary degree of A.M. Following a further discussion by President Patterson it was resolved upon motion that the faculty recommend to the Board of Trustees that the degree of LL.D. be conferred upon Judge Henry S. Barker.

It was stated that the honorary degree of LL.D. was several ^{undoubtedly in 1904} years ago conferred upon Mr. John Shelby of Lexington but that no record of this action could be found, and upon motion it was ordered that the minutes of the faculty be corrected to indicate this action.

Following a request of President Patterson that the faculty should meet upon Wednesday September 2nd., the meeting adjourned.
