James C. Rudd Deft }

The Plff James Rudd states that the Deft James C. Rudd is indebted to him in the sum of Four Thousand Dollars money loaned to & paid for said James C. Rudd by said James Rudd

The Plff further states that to secure the payment of the said Four Thousand Dollars, the Deft James C. Rudd & he the said James Rudd did on the 20th day of January 1862 make a mortgage to him the said James Rudd of all the personal property he the said James C. Rudd was possessed of in the County of Davis, State of Kentucky; - consisting of Horses Cattle Sheep Hogs &c etc <sup>and the Plff further states that the Deft James C. Rudd did on 24th day of January 1862 did execute said mortgage & acknowledge it before before the County Clerk of Davis, Lesley and left the same for record. The Plff further states that said mortgage was recorded in January 1862 in Mort Book No 2 Page 291 after being duly acknowledged by both the said James C. Rudd & the said James Rudd.</sup>

The Plff James Rudd further states that the said James C. Rudd bound himself - in said mortgage - his heirs assigns or representatives to pay to said James Rudd said sum of Four Thousand Dollars in One Two Three & Four years
