

This Indenture made and entered into
 this 21st day of August 1863 between John
 Locke late Sheriff of Davess ^{State of Kentucky} County
 of the one Part and James Rudd of
 the County of Jefferson + State of Kentucky
 of the other Part Witnesseth that whereas
 an execution issued from the cks office
 of the Davess Circuit Court against
 James C. Rudd + in favor of W. C. Norris
 for the sum of \$2,116.⁰⁰ with interest from
 the 1st April 1861 until paid + \$1.80 cost and
 one against the same in favor of N. Cligam
 for the sum of \$398.⁰⁰ with interest from
 the 15th day of July 1861 + \$1.80 cost + one in
 favor of Wm. P. Bell + against the same
 for the sum of \$199.¹⁵ with interest from
 the 12th day of July 1861 + \$1.80 cost which
 Executions were directed + delivered to said
 Locke Sheriff as of old + were by him levied
 upon a certain lot of ~~land~~ ^{land} ~~and two brick store houses~~ ^{and two brick store houses} ~~on the same~~
 described and the said J. C. Rudd failing
 to execute bond for the payment of said
 executions the said property was duly
 advertised + appraised and the said
 Locke did on the 15th day of May 1863
 proceed to expose the same to public
 auction at the Court House door in
 Owensboro when & where James Rudd the
 party of the ~~second~~ ^{second} being the highest bidder
 became the purchaser thereof at + for the
 sum of \$3425.⁰⁰ which amount was paid
 me in hand and was the party of the first
 Part for and in consideration of the said
 sum of thirty seven hundred + twenty five
