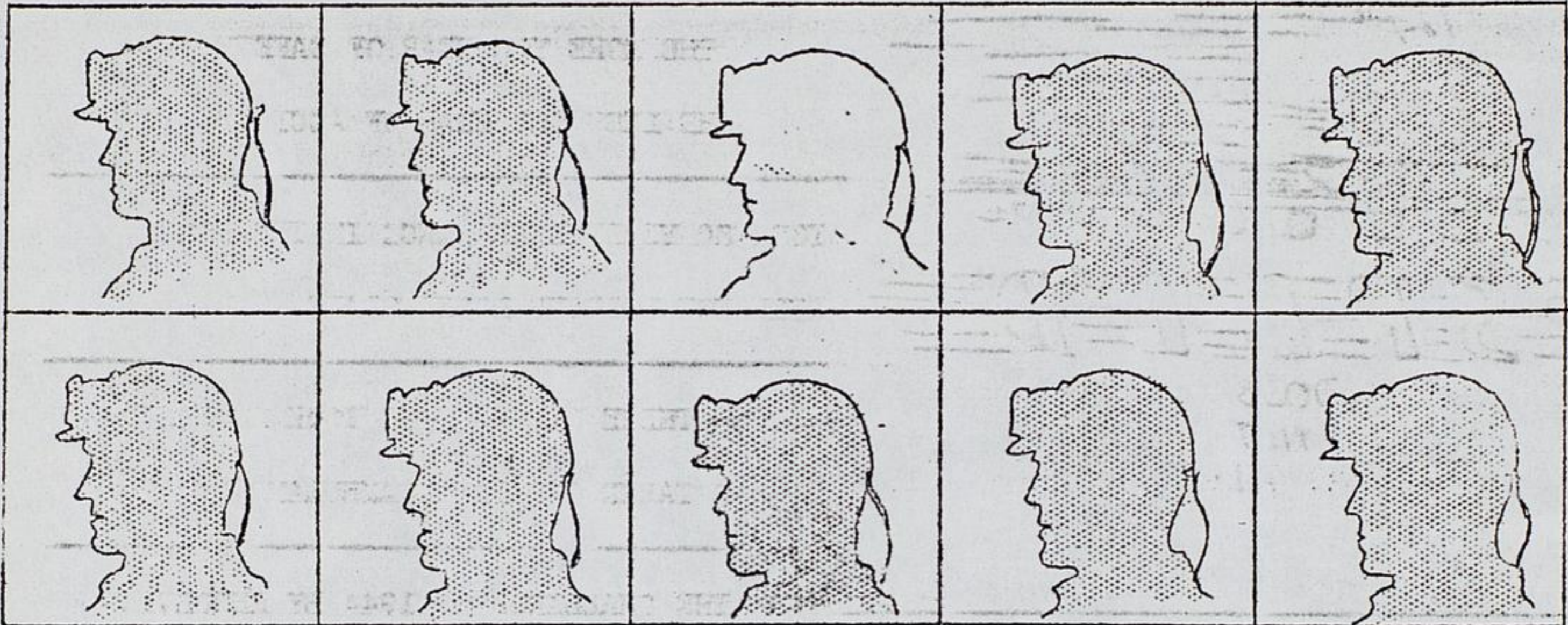


# ONE OUT OF EVERY TEN WILL BE INJURED OR KILLED 1944!



## YOU NEED NOT BE THAT MAN

AN AVERAGE OF ONE OUT OF EVERY TEN MEN WORKING IN AND ABOUT THE COAL MINES IN THIS AND ADJOINING MINING STATES WILL BE INJURED OR KILLED THIS YEAR. THE INJURIES WILL INCLUDE THE BROKEN BONES SUFFERED UNDER SLATE FALLS; THE LOSS OF FINGERS, HANDS, ARMS, TOES, FEET AND LEGS FROM HAULAGE AND MACHINERY ACCIDENTS; THE LOSS OF EYES FROM THE MOST MINUTE PARTICLES OF COAL AND ROCK, AND THE LOSS OF SIGHT FROM INFECTION RESULTING FROM NEGLECTED MINOR EYE INJURIES. ABOUT ONE OUT OF EVERY TWENTY MEN CAUGHT BY A SLATE FALL IS KILLED AND ABOUT ONE OUT OF EVERY FORTY MEN, INJURED FROM ALL CAUSES, WILL DIE AS A RESULT OF THEIR INJURIES.

YOU NEED NOT BE ONE OF THEM. YOU CAN BE SAFER THAN THE AVERAGE MAN WORKING IN THE MINES. THERE ARE MINERS WHO HAVE WORKED THEIR LIFE TIME WITHOUT BEING INJURED. THERE ARE MINES EMPLOYING HUNDREDS OF MEN AND THEY WORK YEAR IN AND YEAR OUT WITHOUT HAVING A MAN INJURED. THE MEN IN SUCH MINES MUST BE CAREFUL. THEY MUST THINK OF THEIR SAFETY AT ALL TIMES.
