Vincent L. Moore of the County of Woodford State of  
Kentucky was the owner of the following named Slaves  
(Nine in number) Viz. Charles 21 years of age, George 37  
years of age, James Buford 22 years of age, Peggy 18 years of age  
Paulina 36 years of age, Jack 14 years of age, Thomas 12  
years of age, Nancy 10 years of age, and Eliza 2 years of  
age - That said Vincent L. Moore was deprived of said  
Slaves by their loss under the following circumstances Viz.

Charles left him in May 1864 and joined the Federal army  
George left him in June 1864 and joined the federal army  
James Buford left him in Sep. 1864 and joined the Federal army  
Peggy was the wife of a Colonel Federal Soldier

Said Slaves, Charles, George, James Buford, and Peggy, were  
worth and of the Value of, each as follows Viz. Charles \$750.00  
George \$750.00 James Buford \$750.00 and Peggy \$550.00  
on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Jan. 1863 -

Paulina Jack Thomas<sup>and</sup> Nancy were lost by the adoption  
of the 13<sup>th</sup> amendment to the Constitution of the United States.  
were worth and of the Value each as follows Viz. Paulina  
\$550.00 Jack \$550.00 Thomas \$550.00 and Nancy \$250.00  
on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Jan. 1863 - Eliza was born since the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of Jan. 1863 was worth and of the Value of \$100.00 at  
the time of their loss.

And we further state that we have no knowledge or infor-  
-mation of any compensation having been made to the said  
Vincent L. Moore nor did he sell any of said Slaves  
to any Person
