

W.M. College of Kentucky, Oct 17-1904

The faculty met at the call of the president in his office directly after chapel, to receive the report of the committee appointed to consider the petition of Miss Scruggs and fourteen other young women of the college, for permission to establish a second literary society for women.

The committee reported that after hearing the petitioners, and also the officers of the Philosophian society who opposed the granting of the petition, it was constrained to report adversely upon the petition.

A motion to adopt the report of the committee was lost.

Upon motion of Prof. Kasite it was ordered that the petitioners be given permission to establish a second literary society as desired.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned.
