KNOW YE, That by virtue and in consideration of *a* Kentucky Land-Office Warrant, No. *13017*
there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto *James McQuinn*

a certain TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, containing *fifty* acres, by survey
bearing date the *25th* day of *July* one thousand eight hundred and *twenty five*
lying and being in the County of *Carter* on the North side of the North fork of the Kentucky
River and bounded as followeth to-wit Beginning at Allen's upper corner
of his survey of 400 acres above where Joseph Braden lives at a sugar tree
and white Walnut marked T. C. thence up said fork with its meanders
N 44° East 140 poles to a white Walnut and buckeye thence North 45° West
57 poles to a chestnut and Hickory on a point of rock, thence S 44° West
140 poles to a stake, thence S 45° East 57 poles to the Beginning

With its appurtenances: To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of LAND, with its appurtenances, to the said *James McQuinn*

and *his* heirs forever
