

STATE OF KENTUCKY. SCT.

In obedience to an order of the honorable the Federal Court at their November term 1816, I appeared on the land in controversy between Samuel Smith, plaintiff against William McGuire and others defendants on an ejectment on the 23rd day of Feby 1818, by adjournments from the 9th instant, Samuel Plummer appeared as agent for the plaintiff. I then proceeded to execute said order as follows towit: I began at the mouth of the middle fork at A and ran N. 14. o E 1034 poles to B, and from B to C corner. I found trees anciently marked as

line trees in two places on said line. I then proceeded by actual survey to ascertain the precise situation of the dwelling houses of the 11 defendants in said suit, and

is represented in the annexed platt, severally thus from No II. as per the following

explanation

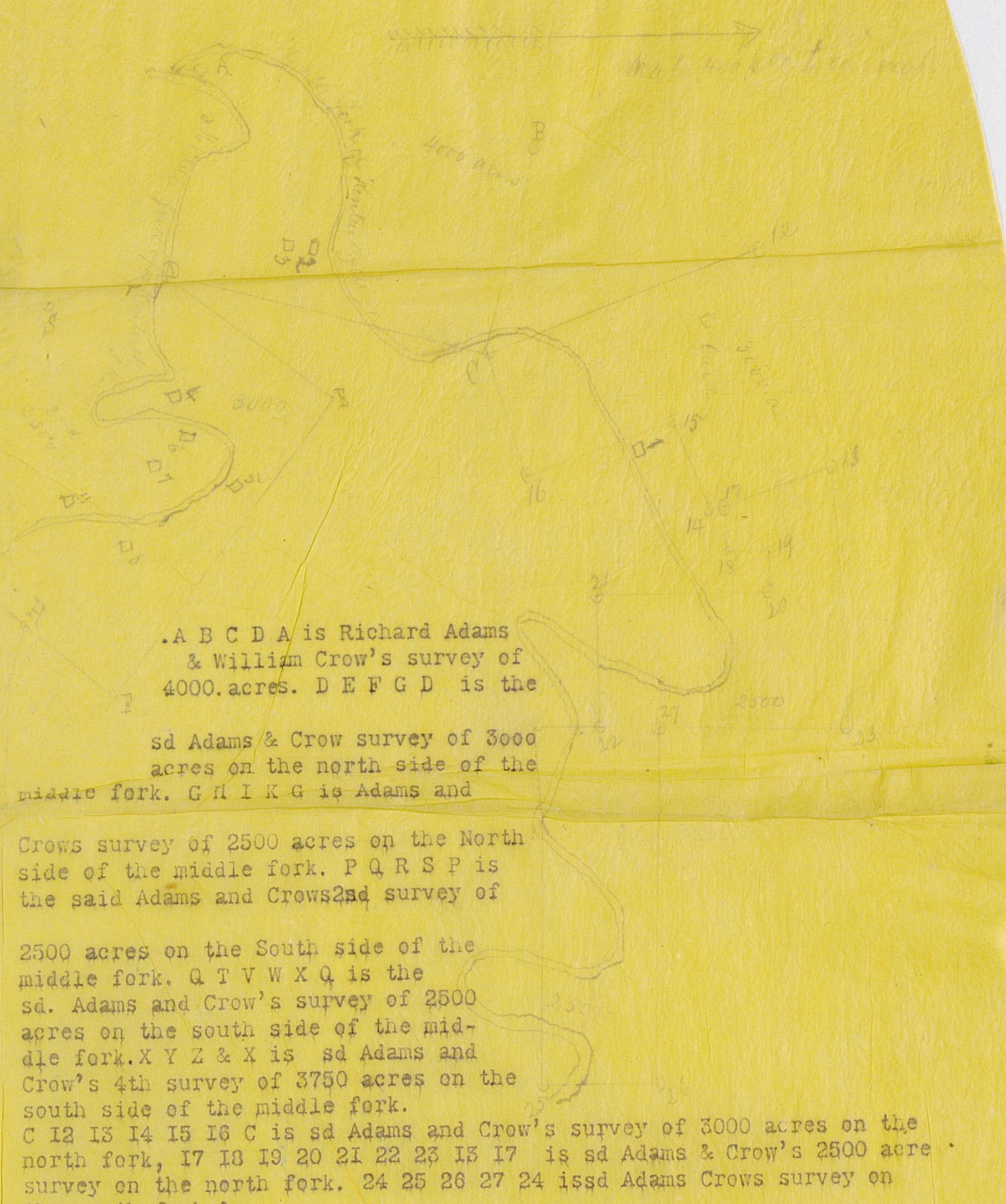

The defendants in this suit give no direction in executing this survey
The plaintiff Samuel Smith by his agent Samuel Plummer also produced to me on the ground his deeds from William Crow to the plff Smith for certain undivided tracts of land to the amount of 10 deeds as per connexion, bearing date the 12th day of April 1796.
