J. H. Trumble, &c., Pliffs. vs. Wm. Pryor, &c., Defts.

The defendants, Jasper Spencer, Wm. Prior, Jas^t Buchanan, Wm. Buchanan, Ky. Union Land Company, Ky. Union Lumber Co. and R. H. Judy, and all persons under them are hereby enjoined and restrained from cutting, destroying or removing, any of the timber on the following described tract of land to wit:

"Beginning at the light house which is on top of the Sand Cliffs, on the point west of, or below Swifts Camp Creek, and between it and the north fork of Red River, and is on the old Morgan and Montgomery County line, which line is the dividing ridge between the waters of Swifts Camp Creek, on the eastern and waters of Chimney Top creek, and Parch Corn branch on the western side of said ridge (In naming of the hereinafter sand cliffs are meant unless otherwise named) thence from said light house down with the meanders of the cliffs of and on the southern side of said north fork, to a point of cliffs east of, or above parch Corn branch, and between it and said fork; thence a straight line westwardly to a point of cliff first west of said branch, and between it and said fork; thence on down with the cliffs of said fork to a point of cliff east of Laurel branch, and between it and said fork and on Wm. Bedford's line; thence his line around with the meanders of the cliffs of said branch, and between it and said fork; thence down with the cliffs on the southern side of said fork to the Powell Rose line (which line is part of the said cliffs on the southern side of said fork and its waters) to the point of cliff on the point between said fork of Red River, and Chimney Top creek, thence with said line and the sand cliffs on the eastern side of said and up with same to a point of cliff opposite the forks of said creek; thence a straight line westwardly or north-westwardly, course to the forks of said creek; thence a north-west course to the sand cliffs, on the western side of said Creek; thence down with the meanders of said cliff on the western side of said creek and with said Rose line, to a point of said cliff, and on said line about 250 or 300 yards S-E of Pinch Em Tight Gap, near the head of a small branch or draw, that runs into said creek near and above the Old Powell Rose House, and on the line between the Dean Terrisons, 22000 acre, and Jno. Carnan, 10000 acre patents and surveys; thence on down with said Rose line and cliffs to the foot of Pinch Em Tight Gap, on the dividing ridge between the
