

This Indenture made this 5th day of April
1883. Between Evaline Roberts of the County
of Powell & State of Kentucky, of the First Part
And The Central Kentucky Lumber Mining Man-
ufacturing & Transportation Company
incorporated under the law of the State aforesaid
of the Second Part. Witnesseth that the
said party of the first part for & in consideration
of the sum of Seventy Nine Dollars & Twenty eight
Cents Cash in hand paid, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged has bargained & sold
and by these presents grants & conveys unto
the said party of the Second part their heirs and
assigns forever a certain tract of Land
situated on the road leading from the Red
River Lumber Mills to the mouth of Black
Creek in Powell County Kentucky & on the East
side of said road about four hundred Yards
from said Mill & which is bounded as follows
to wit: Beginning on Stone on the North Side
of the County Road leading from Stanton
to the Forge near where the Black Creek Road
leaves said road thence along the Side
of the road North fifty degrees West $11\frac{84}{100}$ poles
to Stone set in ground thence N. 23. E.
 $13\frac{5}{10}$ Poles to Stone set in ground on the
edge of a drain thence S 50 E $11\frac{84}{100}$ poles
to Stone set in ground thence S 23 N $13\frac{5}{10}$
poles to the beginning Containing One acre of Land
