Variation of needle  $3^{\circ} 50$  East. --Scale 300 poles per inch.  
May 5th. 1784. --Surveyed for Samuel Underwood, the quantity of 20000  
acres of land, lying and being in Fayette Co., Va., by virtue of an  
entry made 28th day of Feby., 1784, on 20,000 acres, part of a  
Treasury Warrant No. 18571: "Beginning at the letter A. a hickory  
being the North East corner of a tract of land of 20,000 acres,  
surveyed for Terrison & Brothers and in a  $N 9^{\circ}$  West line drawn  
from the mouth of the North Fork of the Three Forks of Ky. River;  
thence

S  $81$  W 1500 poles to B. a white oak; thence  
N  $9$  W 2000 poles at C. to a walnut; thence  
N  $81$  E 1500 poles to D. a hickory; thence  
S  $9$  E 2000 poles to the Beginning.
