

Survey No. 7.--Madison Co.

Surveyed for the heirs of Nathaniel Hart, deceased, 500 acres of land by virtue of part of a former survey, situated lying and being in the County of Madison, on Goose Creek, a South branch of Kentucky River, and bounded as followeth, viz:

Beginning at a beech tree standing in a line of a former survey of 2000 acres made for the Heirs of the said Hart; thence with a line of the same

S 70 W 250 poles to B. a white oak standing in a line of the former 2000 acres; thence

S 10 E 325 poles, bounded by lands not fit for cultivation, to C., three white oaks; thence

N 80 E 225 poles to D. a black oak tree; thence

N 7 W 355 poles, bounded by lands not fit for cultivation, to the beginning.--Variation $2^{\circ} 30'$ East. Laid down by a scale of 200 poles to an inch.
