

The following is a copy of notes taken from a field book of Thomas Hart a former Surveyor of Clark County Ky who was the father of Mr. Andrew Hart who resides near Winchester in said County and in whose possession this book now is Dec 1889 and which are as follows. Viz,

Monday. 17th Nov 1823

Met according to adjournment and proceeded to the upper corner of the Holder & Graham Survey of 33815 acrs. which is the beginning corner of Holder and Gayles Survey of 49.665 1/2 acrs.

There is an elm and sycamore anciently and plainly marked on the north bank of the Ky. River on the upper margin of a deep ravine about one quarter of a mile above the mouth of Drowning Creek from thence pursued by the call of the patent line binding on the said River as it meanders
