Madison Sst September 29th 1797

Surveyed for Thomas Shore 1000 acres of land upon a treasury warrant No.-----Situat in the forks of Kentucky River bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at the mouth of the South fork of said Kentucky river formerly called Goose Creek three maples at A running from thence up Goose Creek or the South fork the meanders thereof in all 562 poles, to a red oak and sugar tree standing on the bank of the creek or River at B. from thence running across to the Main river N 22° E 650 poles to three sugar trees and a Lynn standing on the bank of the river at C. thence down the river the meanders thereof to the beginning.
