Memorandum of Agreement,
made this the 25th day of January,
1883, in Paris Kentucky, between the
Central Kentucky Lumber Manufacturing
Company, incorporated by the legislature
of Kentucky of the first part, and the
firm of Thomas & Horcross, of the
County of Powell, Kentucky of the
second part. Witnesses. The
party of the first part agrees to buy,
and the party of the second part
agrees to sell, the following described
property, on the conditions specified
herein, viz. The property known as
the Red River Mill, & all & singular
the property, connected with the
business, carried on, by the party of
the second part, including Real Estate
timber, purchases or leases, personal
property, in fact everything they own,
or have claim to. The party of the
second part hereby agrees to transfer,
& turn over, with a perfect title, free
of all incumbrances the above mentioned
property, on the 1st of March, 1883. The
party of the second part, further, agrees
to give exclusive control, to the party
