For articles not owned by CRL the requests will be transmitted to the British Library Lending Division (BLLD), using the TYMSHARE computer network. The BLLD will send photocopy of the requested articles directly to the member library. The expected time-lapse on requests to BLLD is 5 to 12 days.

This service will be available only to the students, faculty, and staff of the member institutions and should not be used to fill the needs of researchers at other institutions. The requests should be limited to current research needs and should not be used to fill in missing pages from journals held by the member library unless those pages are needed for current research by a student or faculty member.

The benefits of this new service are twofold. First, the response time should be faster and more economical because Interlibrary Loans won't have to verify locations and pay the charges involved in most transactions. Second, it will allow the library to allocate acquisitions funds for other library needs and not expend those funds on little used journals in the fields of science, technology and the social sciences.

SOLINET TERMINAL SCHEDULE
