## THE FINE ART OF GRANT WRITING

The Kentucky Library Association is sponsoring a pre-conference workshop, "Grantsmanship for Librarians" to be held September 27-28, 1978, Galt House, Louisville. The seminar is designed to present instruction in proposal writing and to provide practice in proposal preparation. The program will also cover skills necessary for locating and contacting available sources for funding. The instructors include Ruth Brown, Associate Director, University of Kentucky Libraries, and Vivian Hall, University of Kentucky Geology Librarian, both of whom have had experience in writing proposals and have attended ASIS and SLA workshops on grants. William F. Schweri, Staff Associate in the Kentucky Research Foundation will also serve as an instructor. The registration deadline is September 7. The \$25.00 registration fee includes materials and lunch on September 27.
