#### ELIGIBILITY GRADE CHANGE

Persons falling in Office and Clerical schedules at secretarial, clerk typist, and library technician series levels will, in limited areas, be considered for "eligibility grade change." This applies only for secretarial grades 14-18 with 2 years working experience, library technicians I-II with 2 years experience, and clerk typist grades 12-16 with 1 year experience. Eligibility for moving upward is contingent upon demonstrated excellent performance as reflected by the annual performance evaluation review and recommendation of the department head.

Employees who are moved up because of eligibility grade change will be taken to the end of probation rate for the new grade. Persons already above the end of probation rate for the new grade will not necessarily receive an increase.
