Labrot & Graham, distillers of a heavy-bodied sour mash bourbon, reports that it will have an extremely limited supply of current production goods to place on the market this Spring.

Jim Crow, one of Kentucky's famous early distillers, was the first distiller for the well-known firm of Labrot & Graham.

The Labrot and Graham distillery began production 97 years ago in 1838. The early practices utilized in distilling whisky have become traditional and are in use today.

Most of the Labrot & Graham plant produc-

tion is being laid down for aging and is being held by the distillery.

C. W. Bixler, Labrot & Graham's distiller now and before Prohibition, said, "I am making exactly the same quality whisky now as I made before Prohibition and this is the finest quality that can be made."

Kentucky ranks the Labrot & Graham plant among the show place distilleries of the state.

Labrot & Graham's distillery is in Woodford County on Glens Creek. Before Prohibition it was this cold, pure, rushing stream that helped produce "Old Oscar," "Old Taylor," and "Old Crow."
