"DO'S AND DON'TS" - WHILE ON LEAVE.

1. (a) REPORTING - If on overnight leave ALL O.Rs except R.A.F. must report to the A.P.M. 123 Hayarkon St., to have their leave passes stamped. The Leave & Accommodation Office will book your accommodation and give you any information you may require.
- (b) R.A.F. PERSONNEL - ALL Ranks must report to the R.A.F. D.A.P.M. at 97 Hayarkon St.
- (c) OFFICERS (other than RAF and WAAF Officers), nursing Officers, and ATS officers will report to the DAPM at 123 Hayarkon St. and sign the leave book. You must have a leave pass.
2. ARMS AND AMMUNITION : Hand into the Armoury at 123 Hayarkon Street.
3. WHERE SHALL I STAY ? : Toc H, War Comforts Hostel, St. Andrew's House, Hibbert House, E.F.I. Women's services club, St. Andrew's Hostel, plus 66 Hotels!
4. BOOKING ROOMS : Don't resent being asked by the hotel for your leave pass. They have been instructed to accept nobody whose current leave pass does not bear a APM's and Town Major's stamp. Write your name in the hotel register.
5. VALUABLES : Take care of your money - you may not have a care in the world today - but what about to-morrow ? Deposit your money in the hotel and obtain a receipt for it.
6. CASUAL PAYMENTS : You cannot get them while on leave. Bring enough money for the whole of your stay.
7. CHANGING MONEY : Don't come here - we have none ! Go to Toc H., Hibbert House, Services Club, Barclay's Bank or Field Cashier (Monday 9 to 10.30 at the C.M.P.)
8. CLUBS : Services Club, Toc H., Church of Scotland, Hibbert House, War Comforts Hostel, Women's Services Club, Women's EFI Club and Ritz Officers Club and Scopus Club (officers).
9. SERVICES CLUB : 91 Hayarkon St. Caters for all. Information Bureau, Cloakroom, Trips to all parts of the country. Dances, shows, cabarets, concerts, parties in the Ark. Home Hospitality.
10. INFORMATION : C.M.P. Information Post, Municipal Bureau with Rest Room, a room to leave your parcels and cloak room.
11. JAFFA : Acquaint yourself with the location of parts which are out of bounds. Maps are placed in all hotels.
12. N.A.A.F.I. : Bulk Store, E.F.I. Shop and Canteen, Citrus House; Beach Canteen, 109 Hayarkon St.
13. PRICES : You will notice signs in cabarets, restaurants and hotels that read 300 mils, 250 mils, 200 mils & 100 mils - Class IV, Class III, Class II, Class I respectively. This is the maximum you should pay for one meal. A 10% service charge only can be added to your bill where you are served at a table. If you think you are overcharged, get an itemized receipt and bring it to the Town Major's Office; we will handle the situation for you.
14. ENTRANCE FEE may be charged where a signed notice to this effect is displayed at the door. A 50 mils maximum for a Cabaret or Dance Band.
15. CABARETS AND DANCING For ALL RANKS at Omanuth, Maxim's, San Remo and Palais de Danse.
16. CIGARETTES : Players and Craven 'A' 95 & 50 mils, Gold Flake, Capstan, State Express, Ardath, 90 & 45 mils. Woodbines 80 & 40 mils packets of 20 and 10 respectively.
17. BEER Class IV, III, and (II & I) respectively. Gold Star 85, 83, and 80; Eagle 74 & 72 and 69 mils; Globus 84, 82 and 79 mils. Draught $\frac{1}{2}$ litre 53, 50 and 48 mils; $\frac{1}{4}$ litre 23, 26 & 24 mils plus 10% service if served at a table. No service charge on drinks served at the bar.
18. CINEMAS : Reduced prices for all Cinemas. From 170 mils to 130 mils, 130 mils to 90 mils, 90 mils to 50 mils. No reduced prices on Saturday. For the best seats full price must be paid. NAAFI performance at Migdalor Friday nights only.
19. (a) BUS FARES : Within Tel Aviv or Jaffa 5 mils.
- (b) TAXI FARES : are regulated by zones. Each driver has a copy of the authorised map with the zones displayed. If in doubt, ask at the Town Major's Office.
20. PHOTOGRAPHERS : Deal only with those shops with "Notice to Military Personnel" in window.
21. POST OFFICE : Army Post Office is situated in Citrus House. Parcels must be posted there. Hours - 11.30 to 12.30 and 13.30 to 15.15. Personnel staying in hotels only will hand their mail into the leave and accommodation office. Your hostel may censor your letters.
22. OVERCHARGING : We may be able to help you, but nothing can be done if you fail to give us a receipted bill. There are special military prices for laundries and barbers - ask to see their price list.
23. CIVILIANS : Don't expect your girl friend to be charged military prices.
24. DO YOU KNOW there is a river with boating, a zoo, an aviary, a museum, and picture gallery, the Palestine Orchestra and riding schools in Tel Aviv. The house of "Simon the Tanner" in Jaffa.
25. BATHING : It is a dangerous beach. Only bathe on recognised bathing beaches, and obey the Life Saver. Do NOT change on the beach; you will probably have your money stolen.
26. PADRE : If you want to have a chat - call at Toc H., Hibbert House, St. Andrew's House or the Services Club. Details of Church services can be seen for EVERY denomination.
27. C.M.P. : The police are here to help you - in return please give them every assistance, but YOU must guard your personal valuables. Remember your saluting !
28. DRESS : Look smart on leave and be a credit to your regiment.
29. LAUNDRY : A military laundry with 27 hours service is situated at 77 Hayarkon St.
30. TAILOR : A military tailor and mender is situated at 77 Hayarkon St.
31. M.I. ROOM : is at CITRUS HOUSE - its Tel. No. 3491.
32. RETURNING : No need to report back to this office. But if returning by train you MUST report to the R.T.O. Tel Aviv Station immediately on arrival in Tel Aviv.
33. Do you value your health ? If so, DON'T overdo the smoking, drinking or sunbathing. DON'T risk V.D., but if you have done so, visit the P.A.C., 70 Ben Yehuda St., (see map). AT ONCE. Always open. DON'T delay : in this case safety is allied to speed.

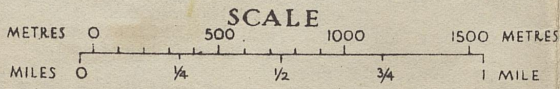
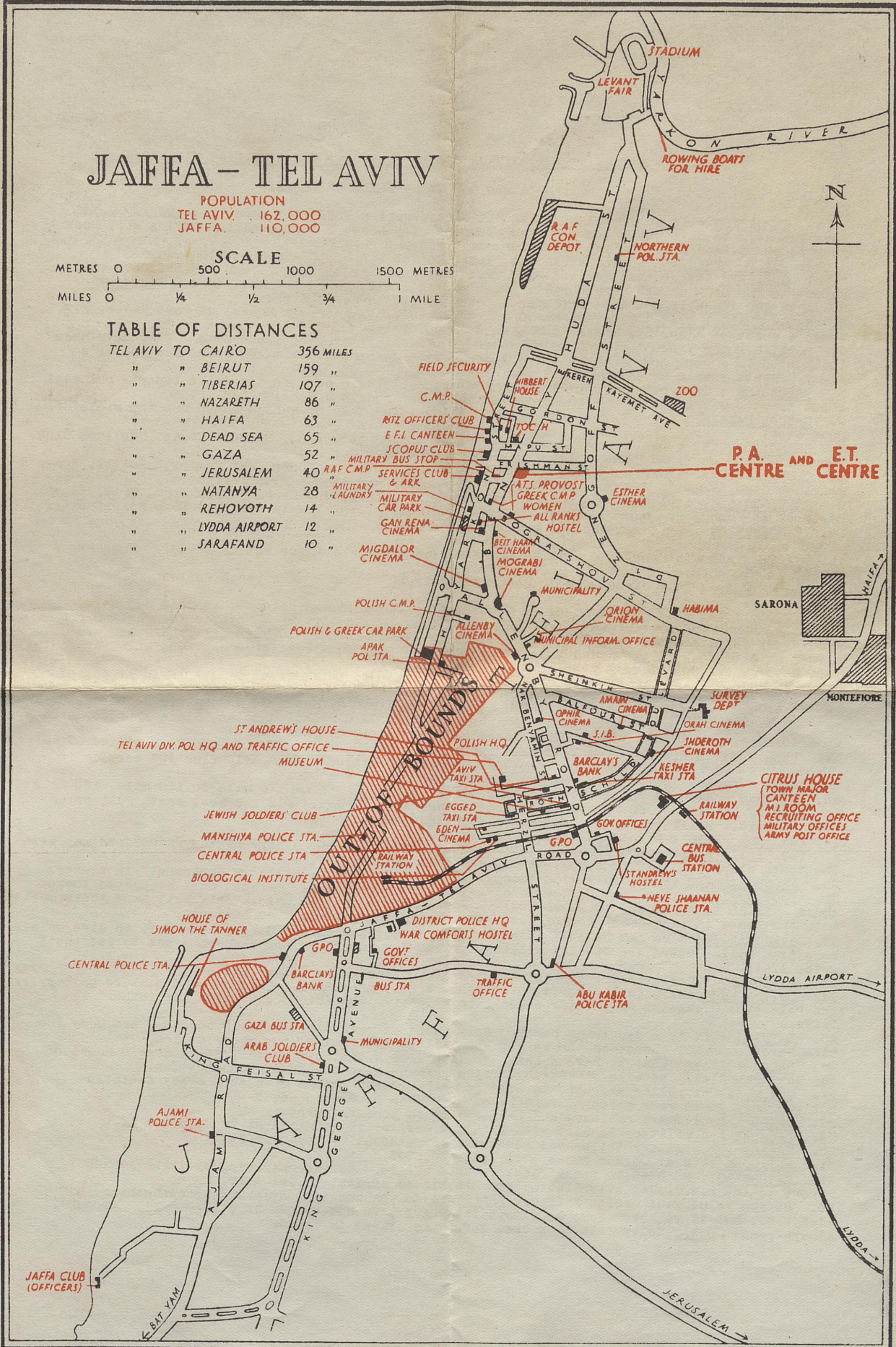

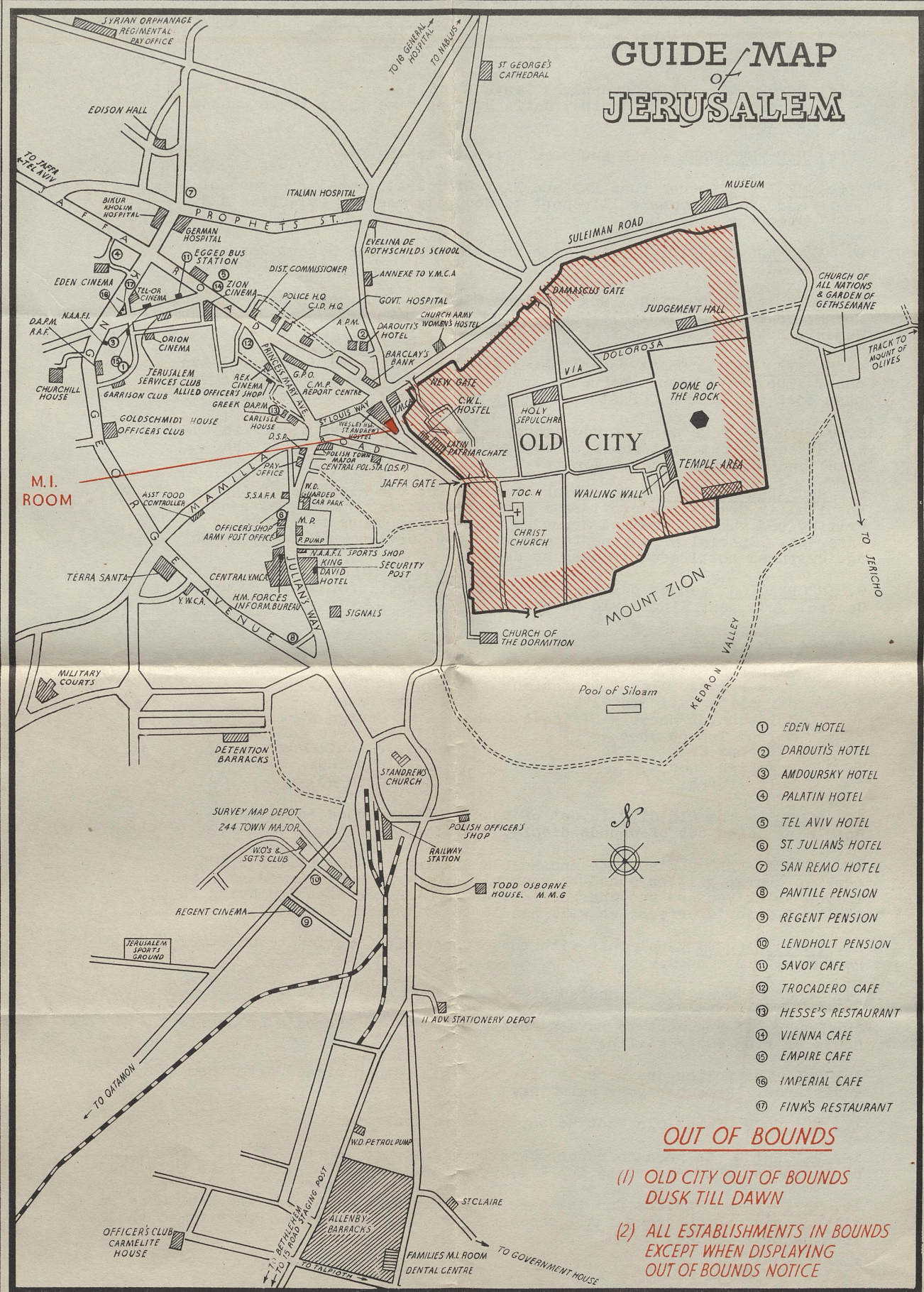
"DO'S AND DON'TS" - WHILE ON LEAVE

- 1.(a) REPORTING - If on overnight leave ALL O.Rs. except RAF must report to the CMP Report Centre, Jaffa Road to have their leave passes stamped.
- (b) RAF PERSONNEL - ALL Ranks must report to the RAF DAPM.
- (c) OFFICERS (other than RAF and WAAF Officers), nursing personnel, and ATS officers will report to Security Post HQ Palestine and sign the leave book.
2. ARMS AND AMMUNITION Hand into the Armoury at CMP Report Centre, Jaffa Road.
3. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION YMCA Services Club, St. Andrews House, CWL Hostel, Toc H, Church Army Carlisle House, Todd Osborne House, YWCA, Church Army Women's Hostel.
4. BOOKING ROOMS Don't resent being asked by the hotel for your leave pass. They have been instructed to accept nobody whose current leave pass does not bear a CMP stamp. Write your name in the hotel register.
5. VALUABLES Take care of your money - you may not have a care in the world today - but what about to-morrow? Deposit your money in the hotel and obtain a receipt for it.
8. JERUSALEM SERVICES CLUB which is run under the auspices of the Jewish Hospitality Committee, provides a canteen, information office, reading, writing and games rooms and arranges sightseeing tours to places of interest. Special arrangements are made for Servicemen to stay at an agricultural settlement if they so desire.
9. INFORMATION can be obtained from H.M. Forces, Information Bureau, Central YMCA near King David Hotel.

11. BOUNDS - The Old City is out of bounds between dusk and dawn. Hotels or Cafes out of bounds display notices.
12. PRICES - ALL Restaurants and Hotels display a PRICE LIST. A 10% service charge will be added to your bill where you are served at a table. If you think you are overcharged, get an itemized receipt and bring it to the Town Major's office; we will handle the situation for you.
13. PHOTOGRAPHERS Deal only with those shops with "Notice to Military Personnel" in window.
14. PARCELS must not be posted at the civilian Post Office.
15. PADRE If you want to have a chat - call at St. Andrew's or Carlisle House or ring 4651/Ext.115.
16. CMP The police are here to help you - in return please give them every assistance. Remember your saluting.
17. M.I.ROOM is at Old Fast House, Nr. Barclays Bank.
18. RETURNING No need to report back to CMP Report Centre. But if returning by train you MUST report to the R.T.O., Jerusalem Station 72 hrs. in advance.
19. TAXI FARES Tariffs for the hire of public motor vehicles are published in all Hostels and Canteens. All cases of overcharging will be reported to the Town Major's Office.

DON'T risk V.D., but if you have done so, visit the M.I.Room, Old Fast House, Nr. Barclays Bank, AT ONCE. Always open. DON'T delay, in this case safety is allied to speed.
