I have made inquiry in regard to the hush seed and I find that I cannot interest the farmers at a price that I can furnish the seed to you for less than \$2⁴⁰ per bu delivered, for the third year importation. I will have to reclean the seed after I get them and pay the freight and on above price will have a small margin. if you will agree to take the seed as they are delivered to me I will make them to you for 15¢ per bu less. and early importation of seed, as I have said to you before, do not yield like and older seed and the planters do not like to grow them unless a premium in price is offered. I will furnish you a good lot of seed. would be glad to have your reply by return mail so I could make my arrangements to have them planted.
