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PREFACE

The Directory of Churches, Missions, and Religious Institutions of Tennessee: Davidson County, Nashville, is one of a series of volumes designed to serve as hand books for ministers, laymen, students, and research specialists in the field of church history and in sociological and genealogical investigations. The information contained in this volume will be incorporated in a state-wide directory to be published at a future date. The preparation of the Directory is a necessary preliminary step to insure completeness of inclusion in the Inventory of the Church Archives of Tennessee which is being issued in denominational volumes by the Tennessee Historical Records Survey Project. The number assigned this directory, 19, merely indicates the alphabetical position of Davidson among the counties of the State.

It is the nature of a directory to defy completion. The absence of any similar listing, however, and the belief that such a directory would be of value to students as a hand book has resulted in its issuance. The churches, missions, and religious institutions are listed by denomination with their location, the date of organization, the name of the pastor and his address, and the number of members as given by the pastor or an official. The preparation of this directory called for an examination of printed and manuscript church minutes, yearbooks, city and church directories, and institutional catalogues. These were supplemented by personal interviews with religious and institutional officials, and the denominational lists were checked with members of the respective faiths.

This directory was prepared during the administration of T. Marshall Jones as State Supervisor of the Tennessee Historical Records Survey Project before he resigned to become State Supervisor of the Research and Records Section of the Division of Professional and Service Projects in February 1940. It was compiled by Work Projects Administration workers under the supervision of Robert Cassell, Church Archives Editor of the Tennessee Survey Project; Maurine Cantrell and Milford R. Wheeler rendered much assistance; the field work was done by Mamie Adams, Henry P. Englehardt, Arthur Lackey, and Dorothy St. John. This volume was prepared in accordance with instructions from the Washington office of the Historical Records Survey Program; detailed editorial comments and criticism of the book have been made by Donald A. Thompson, Assistant Archivist in charge of the Church Archives Inventory. Typing of the final draft and cutting of stencils were done by Helen P. Allen and Patsy R. Floyd.

This book is preliminary and is subject to revision. Corrections and additional information are solicited and should be addressed to the State Supervisor, 305 Davidson County Courthouse, Nashville.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. All addresses in this directory are in Nashville or in Davidson County, unless otherwise indicated. In a few instances, names of churches, institutions, or individuals whose addresses or locations are outside of Davidson County have been included because of their connection with or relation to organizations in Davidson County. The churches are listed alphabetically under the proper denomination except in special cases in which, for example, the Cathedral of the Diocese takes precedence over all other churches.
2. The full names and addresses of persons mentioned are given in all cases where the information was available.
3. The exact location of each church or institution is given according to the latest available information. Rural routes are in the vicinity of Nashville unless otherwise indicated. Spelling of streets follows the Nashville City Directory (1940), of pikes and highways the Davidson County Highway Code (1940).
4. The date of organization and the number of members given in each instance are the latest available statistics. The membership in most cases is that claimed by the church. This number generally includes all adult members of the church, although it may in some instances represent only those baptized.
5. The classification system used in this directory, is, in general, that used by the United States Bureau of the Census, Religious Bodies: 1926. The affiliations and chief officials of the various denominations are given to avoid any possible confusion.
6. Although this directory is preliminary to a state-wide listing to be issued subsequently, all the information in this volume has been checked with the various denominational leaders for accuracy and completeness.
7. Besides an alphabetical index of pastors and a church name index, this book includes a community index which indicates the location of all the churches listed.
