I arrived all OK am feeling fine. I have a small cot to sleep on which is big enough. Uncle Henry house is sure
ly cleaned out nothing but the bricks are left. I had some excitement on the train coming out the train was hitting up about 60 am hour when it hit an old man and killed him instantly. I had to laugh I got off the train about a quarter of a mile to soon. I asked a railroad man if that the train up there was headed for Kenton he said yes. I just made it in time as it pulled out immediately I did not even write minutes for the train. Alf certainly fixed up his house well you would not recognize it mother. He tore out most of the small rooms and made two big rooms out of it
